ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

Integrated M.Sc. Ph.D. Programme for the academic year 2013-'14

Applications are invited for admission to the Integrated M.Sc. Ph.D. Programme at the School of Chemical Sciences for the academic year 2013-'14.

Duration of the Programme : Six years (M.Sc. 2 years and Ph.D. 4 years)

Intake of students: 12 (Twelve Only)

Eligibility for Admission:

B.Sc. Degree in Chemistry with Mathematics and Physics as Subsidiaries with not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in Part III.

3 seats are reserved for candidates having degree in Physics with Mathematics and Chemistry as Subsidiaries with not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in Part III.

General Information

The Integrated M.Sc. Ph.D. Programme which is a complementary Programme to the existing conventional M.Sc. Programme is being launched at the School of Chemical Sciences with effect from the academic year 2013-'14.

The Integrated M.Sc. Ph.D. Programme is designed to attract bright and highly motivated Science graduates in Chemistry or Physics with an excellent academic record at the B.Sc. level and with an aptitude for research so that they can pursue a Ph.D. Degree at the School of Chemical Sciences. Upon successful completion of two years in the Programme, the candidates will be awarded a Master's Degree. Those students not continuing in the Programme would have to refund the Scholarship amount paid to them within one year of completion of the M.Sc. Programme. The M.Sc. Degree would be awarded only on fulfillment of this condition. The candidates with a minimum grade point would continue to work for their Ph.D. advancing the topic of their M.Sc. dissertation with the same guide or if necessary, embark upon a new subject with another guide. The candidates should satisfy all the administrative requirements of the University along the way and submit their Ph.D. thesis to the University not later than the end of the sixth year.

The student intake for the existing four conventional M.Sc. Programmes of the School of Chemical Sciences is curtailed to 5 seats each from the sanctioned strength of 8 seats and the 12 seats thus derived are earmarked for the Integrated Programme. Accordingly, the revised seat position of the Programme offered at the School of Chemical Sciences from 2013-14 academic year is as follows.

M.Sc. Chemistry (Inorganic Chemistry)	- 5
M.Sc. Chemistry (Organic Chemistry)	- 5
M.Sc. Chemistry (Physical Chemistry)	- 5
M.Sc. Chemistry (Polymer Science)	- 5

General Instructions

1. Application forms can be downloaded from the Website www.mgu.ac.in. Application forms are not available at any other source.
2. Candidates should remit the REGISTRATION FEE of Rs. 400/-. The REGISTRATION FEE can be remitted by way of challan/Pay-in-slip at any branch of SBT (Challan can be downloaded from the University website)/University CASH COUNTER/FRIENDS JANASEVANA KENDRAM. SC/ST candidates need to pay only 50% of the registration fee. Those candidates who have already applied for the conventional M.Sc. Programme of the School of Chemical Sciences vide Notification No. Ac A1/2/2408/2013 dated 27.05.2013, should submit a fresh application indicating their order of preference if they are desirous of applying for the Integrated M.Sc. Ph.D. Programme also. Such candidates need not remit registration fee again. In their case a copy of the pay-in-slip in respect of the earlier remittance of registration fee for the M.Sc. Programme should be submitted alongwith the fresh application.
3. **Last date for receipt of filled up application forms along with the Registration fee in the Office of the Deputy Registrar (Acad I), Mahatma Gandhi University, Priyadarsini Hills P.O., Kottayam - 686 560 is 15.06.2013. The name of the course and the School to which applied for shall be superscribed on the envelope.**
4. Candidates awaiting final year results of qualifying examination can also apply, provided they produce mark list of the qualifying examination before the finalization of the rank list.
5. Admission to the Programmes shall be on the basis of the marks/grades obtained in the qualifying examination and common entrance examination (in the ratio of 50:50).
6. A Common Entrance Test of one hour duration will be held on 22.06.2013 at selected Centres in Kottayam and Ernakulam. The Entrance Test shall comprise of objective type multiple choice questions.
7. All other rules of admission in respect of the M.Sc. Programme shall be applicable in respect of the Integrated M.Sc. Ph.D. Programme as well.
