*Sub:—Armed Forces Flag Day, 2016—Observance of—Instructions—  
Issued.*

1. The Armed Forces Flag Day is observed by the Nation every year on 7th December, as a mark of our respect and gratitude to the martyrs who sacrificed their lives for national integrity, to the ex-servicemen who gave the precious years of their lives for the defence of the nation and to the members of the Armed Forces whose valour, dedication and loyalty make our lives and motherland secure.

2. The Flag Day Fund, which provides financial assistance to Ex-servicemen, widows and their children, is raised by way of sale of car flags and token flags. In order to promote the collection of funds, the Flag Day Fund Committee chaired by the Chief Minister has instituted Rolling Trophies to the District, the Educational institution, and the NCC Battalion, which make the maximum collection in addition to the Consolation Rolling Trophy to the best District from among the smaller and lesser populated Districts of Kasaragod, Wayanad and Idukki. The District, Institution and the NCC Battalion that win the Rolling Trophy continuously for three times is allowed to retain the Trophy permanently from the Flag Day, 2009 onwards.

3. The Director of Public Instruction, Director of Collegiate Education, Director of Technical Education, Director of Medical Education, Director of Vocational Higher Secondary Education and Director of Higher Secondary Education should ensure that the Heads of offices and Institutions under their control extend all possible co-operation for the sale of flags and settlement of accounts in time.

4. The Additional Director General, NCC (Kerala and Lakshadweep) should extend all help including participation of Flag Day Eve March by Cadets in each District in consultation with Director of Sainik Welfare/ Zila Sainik Welfare Officer.

5. The Heads of Departments, District Collectors, Social Welfare Organizations and Educational institutions will put their best efforts and whole hearted co-operation for the success of the Flag Day Celebrations, 2016 and for the maximum fund collection. Proceeds of the collection are to be sent by way of Cash/Crossed Demand Draft/Money Order to the Director of Sainik Welfare or to the Zila Sainik Welfare Officer concerned, whose addresses are given below. The officers concerned will issue proper receipt for the amount.
