NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited for admission to M.S.W. (Master of Social Work) programme offered in affiliated colleges for the academic year 2015-2016.

Duration of the programme: The duration of the programme is two years, consisting of four semesters.

Eligibility: Any bachelor's degree from Mahatma Gandhi University or any other Universities recognized by Mahatma Gandhi University with an aggregate of 50% (or CGPA of 2) for Part I,II&III put together. SC/ST candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination. SEBC and OEC candidates will be given a relaxation of 3% and 5% respectively in the prescribed minimum marks.

Weightage: Weightage of marks for proficiency in NCC/NSS etc. and bonus marks for Ex-Servicemen applicants and widows and children of Jawans/ Ex-Servicemen will be given as per the existing rules of admission. Reservation for candidates with outstanding records in sports and games shall be allowed as per rules. 3% of the seats under Merit quota are reserved for physically challenged candidates.

How and When to apply: Application forms can be downloaded from the website of the Mahatma Gandhi University (www.mgu.ac.in) from 4th July 2015 onwards. An application fee of Rs. 500/- (Rs.250/-for SC/ST candidates) shall be remitted either at the cash counter of the University or at FRIENDS JANASEVANAKENDRAM or by way of M.G. University Chalan (A/C No. 67114059391) of State Bank of Travancore. Fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances. **The candidates are required to submit applications in the office of the Deputy Registrar I(Acad), CAT CELL, M.G. University, Priyadarsini Hills, Kottayam PIN 686 560.** However, admission to management seats shall be made by the management concerned from the rank list prepared by the University.

Candidates awaiting results of the qualifying examinations are also eligible to apply for admission provided they shall produce the proof of qualification on or before the date of counselling by the University.

A self- addressed stamped envelope(Rs 5/-) shall be enclosed along with the application. The last date for receipt of filled in application is **15.07.2015**.

Mode of selection: Admission to the programme is based on a **common admission test** which is **mandatory for all candidates. Admission will be based on the marks secured in the entrance test only.** The entrance test is of one hour duration consisting of 50 objective type multiple choice questions each of which carries four choices.

Scoring Scheme: Each correct response will be awarded one mark and there will be no negative marks. There will be no provision for revaluation.

Centres of Entrance Test: The details such as the venue and timing of the Entrance Test will be there in the Admit Card.

Classification of Seats: In aided stream, admission of students shall be made on the following pattern: Open quota(on the basis of merit)- 50%(40% for Backward Community colleges) SC/ST - 20%, Community Quota- 10% (20% for Backward Community colleges). The remaining seats will be filled by the educational agency by candidates of its choice from the rank list to be prepared by the University.

One seat at Rajagiri College of Social Sciences is earmarked for N.S.S Certificate holders vide U.O.No.Ac.A1/2/Admn/91-92 dated 3/6/91 and it shall be met from the sanctioned strength of seats under merit quota. In unaided stream 50% of the seats shall be filled by the managements from among candidates of their choice from the rank list prepared by the University. 65% of the remaining seats, (i.e. of 50%) shall be filled on general merit and 35% shall be filled by candidates belonging to SC/ST and other backward communities in the order of merit with the following quota for each community.

Scheduled Caste -	8%
Scheduled Tribe -	2%

Ezhava, Thiyya & Billavan -	9%
Muslim -	8%
Latin Catholic other than Anglo Indians -	2%
Other Backward Christian -	1%
Other Backward Hindus -	5%

Centralized Allotment Process

Admission /Allotment of seats under merit quota is governed by a Centralised Allotment Process. Selection/ Allotment of a candidate to any college will be based on the rank of the candidate and the availability of the seats. A reserved category candidate entitled to admission on the basis of his/her merit will be deemed to have been admitted as an open category candidate and not as a reserved category candidate. Allotment Memo will be issued to the selected candidates after the Centralized Allotment Process. It is obligatory for the candidates to report to the college to which he/she is allotted. Failure to appear before the Principal concerned for joining the course on the prescribed date and time will result in the forfeiture of his/her claim for admission to the course and he/she will not be considered for any vacancies arising in future. Vacancies arising after the first round of allotment of seats will be filled up according to the rank of the candidate and reservation norms. Option exercised at the time of counselling will be final and the candidate is bound to accept the allotment as per the option. There will be no mutual transfer between the candidates from one college to another.
