ORDER

The Syndicate vide paper read (1) above, resolved to authorize the Controller of Examinations to grant condonation of shortage of attendance up to five days and further resolved to authorize the Pro-Vice-Chancellor to grant shortage of attendance from six to ten days for registration of all University Examinations. As per Section 23 (XIX) of Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985 the Syndicate shall have the power to delegate any of its powers to the Vice-Chancellor or to a committee from among its members. This matter was brought to the notice of the Syndicate vide paper read (3) above.

The Syndicate vide paper read (4) above, resolved to delegate the powers of the Syndicate regarding the condonation of shortage of attendance to the Vice-Chancellor.
