

## **PG DIPLOMA COURSE IN INDIAN SIGN LANGUAGE INTERPRETING**

The post graduate Diploma Course in Indian Sign Language is for duration of one year with two Semesters. The course is designed by incorporating RCI Syllabus of ISL A Level, B. Level and C level.

The programme can also be conducted as two year course to facilitate the PG students of the school as an add on Course or part time programme for teachers, Parents of person with hearing impairment and other interested candidates Provided that there will not be any change in the syllabus and evaluation. The examination shall be conducted the end of each year as in the case of each semester.

- 1. Entrance qualification :** a candidate shall be eligible for admission to the PG diploma course in Indian Language provided he/she shall be a Graduate in any subject. Those who know how to sign will get preference.
- 2. Intake :** a maximum of 15 student can be admitted
- 3. Examination :** There will 2 theory and 2 practical for 1<sup>st</sup> Semester and for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester There will be 2 Theory papers and one practical and one project. A candidate shall be declared to have passed the exam if he/she secures 50% of the marks in each theory papers and 70% in the each practical exam. A candidate who has failed in any exams may present himself/herself for a total of 3 attempts.

#### **4. Certification**

The PG Diploma In Indian Sign Language Examination will be conducted by Department Indian Sign Language, School of Behavioural sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University and PG Diploma shall be awarded by Mahatma Gandhi University to the passed candidate.
