### ORDER

The meeting of the Board of Studies in Social Work (PG) held on 04.06.2016 discussed on certain anomalies in the Scheme of Examination of M. Phil Degree Programme in Social Work at affiliated colleges pointed out by the examination branch. The Scheme shows the external marks, whereas the Question Paper shows weightage and this confused the examiners who valued the scripts. A disparity in the grading system and classification on the Scheme of 2015-16 admission is observed. In order to sort out the above problems, an urgent meeting of the Board of Studies in Social Work (PG) was convened and the Board of Studies vide minutes read as (1) recommended the following:

# I. To solve the Anomalies in the Scheme of M.Phil Social Work

1.1) External marks and weightage disparity – 2014-15 admissions

As per the approved scheme and syllabus, the evaluation is based on marks. But the question papers of the examinations of the M. Phil 1<sup>st</sup> Semester were based on weightage. The maximum weightage was 30. The Board recommended to follow the approved scheme of valuation based on marks. Hence the scores obtained by candidates should be converted into marks.

For a thirty (30) weightage course, maximum weighted Grade point (WGP) should be 120 as the score equivalent to the highest grade is 4. The Board recommended a formula which is as follows

Weighted grade point obtained by the candidate (WGP)

X Maximum marks assigned for the examination

Marks =

Maximum weighted Grade Point WGP assigned for the course

eg. For a candidate scoring 60 WGP for a course of maximum 120 WGP in the external examination, conversion into marks will be calculated as 60/120 x 50 where

60 = The assumed WGP secured by the candidate for a course,

120 = The maximum WGP

50 = The maximum assigned marks for the examination

therefore the marks obtained by the candidate is  $\frac{60}{120}x50 = 25$  marks.

1.2) Amendments in the Scheme and Syllabus of 2014-15 M.Phil Social Work – Grading System

The fifth grade, i.e., 'C' assigned to the candidates scoring 40-49 marks out of 100 marks with a grade point 'O' should be declared as 'FAIL' instead of 'Poor'. In the Grading system table (page No.1) of the scheme 'Quality' can be replaced with 'Performance'

# 1.3) Grading of Results (Page No. 10 of the scheme)

Since indirect grading system is recommended to be followed, the grading of results at the end of the programme based on marks is not relevant. Hence the final publication of results can be as per the prescribed grading system. The final grading based on marks given in the scheme page No. 10 titled "grading of results" need not be considered.
