ORDER

The Academic Council vide paper (1) read above, resolved to add an additional provision to Section 17 of the revised regulation for Ph.D Programme 2010/12 for changing research supervising teachers as Proviso 17(ii) and to treat the existing conditions as Proviso 17(i) and to refer the matter of fixing higher fee for changing supervising teachers, except in the case of death/transfer of supervising teacher, to the Syndicate.

The Syndicate Standing Committee on Research & Development considered the matter and resolved to recommend to fix Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) as additional fee for changing research supervising teachers for Ph.D programme, vide paper (2) read above, on the following grounds:

- a) Physical inability of research guide
- b) Mutual consent of both existing and prospective guides
- c) Proven misconduct on the part of the guide
- d) Any other exceptional ground

The Vice Chancellor, exercising powers under Chapter 3, Section 10(17) of Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985, has approved the recommendation of the Syndicate Standing Committee on Research & Development.

Orders are issued accordingly.
