United States – India Educational Foundation (USIEF) was established in 1950 through an agreement between the Governments of U.S. and India. USIEF head office is located in Delhi with regional offices in Chennai, Mumbai, Kolkata and Hyderabad. The Chennai office covers Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Karnataka. USIEF manages the Fulbright Fellowships, the U.S. Government’s flagship program for educational and cultural exchange. The prestigious Fulbright and Fulbright-Nehru Fellowships are fully-funded and enables American researchers and academics to visit India to study, research or to teach. Similarly it also enables Indian academics and researchers to visit the U.S. for professional development purposes. Since 2008, the Government of India is an equal funding partner in the program and hence some of the fellowships are now called the Fulbright-Nehru Fellowships. Both governments recognize USIEF as an organization created and established to facilitate the administration of the Fulbright program in India.
