

The various activities of 2014 covered in this News Letter enable a glimpse of the vibrancy of the Institution at various levels of academic, research and extension. The Indira Gandhi National Award for the best NSS unit marked the fruitful culmination of the wide ranging social and extension activities carried out by our NSS under the leadership of the Co-ordinator Dr: Sabukkuttan, over many years. The academic arena witnessed many National and International seminars, lectures and workshops on contemporary topics providing wider exposure to the Department students, Research scholars and Faculty. Novel initiatives like All India Human Rights Moot Court conducted by School of Indian Legal Thought elicited wide participation.

The Diplomat Lecture Series organized by School of

International Relations and Politics brought well known Diplomats like K.P. Fabian, Sri. Venu Rajamony to the campus to discuss on topical issues. Our faculty went on to win awards for impacting research in Society. Other major initiatives were the Spoken Tutorial Project of HRD ministry and the International Seminar on Robotics by IITians conducted in School of Computer Sciences. Notably, almost all Schools in the University have got involved in a variety of collaborative action research with reputed State and National level institutions like the Nation wide Environmental Gamma Radiation Monitoring using TLD with BRNS (Board of Research in Nuclear Sciences, Dept of Atomic Energy in School of Environmental Sciences). These events give a clear indication of the purposeful movement of the University towards a National Centre of Excellence in the near future.

Environmental Sciences

Arctic expedition – second leg

The successful completion of the first expedition by Dr. Mahesh Mohan, Assistant Professor, School of Environmental Sciences has given an opportunity to visit and collect samples from Arctic environment. The research activities are based on the same project as that of the last year (Mercury Geochemistry in the Sediments of Kongsfjorden, Ny-Alesund, Arctic). This time additional samples were collected from the tree less biome “Tundra” and fresh water lakes of Ny-Alesund for better understanding on the mercury transport and transformation in the region. One of the major achievements in 2014 expedition was the participation of a research scholar from Mahatma Gandhi University. Mr. Gopikrishna V.G. from Dr. Mahesh Mohan’s research group has participated in the expedition and started his Doctoral research utilizing the samples from Arctic Tundra ecosystem.


