

20 Crore Central Assistance to University

The detailed project report presented by the University under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor Dr: Babu Sebastian got central approval for Rs: 20 crores under RUSA (Rashtriya Uchchatha Siksha Abhiyan). The assistance was for

Development of infrastructure facilities. Based on the project report, the fund will be utilized for setting up a solar power plant, Wifi facility, Student amenity/Incubation centre, E-governance/ computerization of Examination Branch, starting Music Science and Research Centre, purchase of Lab equipments, Digitisation of University library, setting up content creation lab and for campus modernization. The fund received so far is being utilized on priority basis.

A number Nobel laureates have visited the University under the Erudite Scholar in Residence programme of the Kerala State Higher Education Council.



Digital India Work shop





The main features of the application are Automatically generate bibliographies, Collaborate easily with other researchers online, Easily import papers from other research software, Find relevant papers based on what you're reading, Access your papers from anywhere online.
