G. University, Kottayam, Kerala** payable at **SBI, Mahatma Gandhi University Campus Branch.**
4. All other charges including VAT/CST, Excise Duty and other levies payable by C.I.P should be clearly indicated. Otherwise it will be presumed that the rates quoted are inclusive of all these charges and will not be paid
5. The Excise Duty component (with percentage) should be indicated, as the University is exempted from the payment of Custom/Excise Duty. Exemption will be availed by providing Custom/Excise Duty Exemption Certificate with order.
6. The Delivery Schedule, Payment Terms & Warranty/Guarantee etc. must be clearly indicated in the technical bid. The charges for extended warranty and/or Annual Maintenance Contract after the expiry of offered warranty period should also be specified in the financial bid.
7. The manufacturers’ printed literature/catalogue/drawing/user’s list in respect of range of product being quoted should also be submitted with the offer.
