Aim Of the course

To acquire knowledge in Sastrakavyas - the poetic works in Sanskrit literature which form an illustration of Sastras like vyakarana.

Objective:

1. To help the students get an awareness of the poetic beauty and literary merit of the poem Dhatukavya which deals with the story of Lord Krsna.
2. To help the students acquire knowledge so as to appreciate a grammatical poem through the study of the Dhatukavaya which forms a good example of Sastrakavya illustrating the roots according to Dhatupatha.
3. To make the students understand and appreciate Narayana Bhattatiri as an erudite scholar, a good poet and a great grammarian..
