NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for Written Aptitude Test (WAT) for registration for research leading to the award of Ph.D. Degree of this University for various disciplines for the year 2018.

1. Eligibility to apply

Candidates who have passed the Post-Graduate examination in any discipline of Mahatma Gandhi University or of other Universities recognised as eligible thereto, securing not less than 55% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate (without adding grace mark), and who secured a P.G Degree or an equivalent Professional Degree satisfying the condition detailed above from a foreign educational institution which is accredited by authorised agencies are eligible to apply for the Written Aptitude Test.

Candidates belonging to the SC/ST Category, OBC (Non Creamy layer), Differently - Abled, and those who have obtained their Masters Degree prior to 19th September 1991 are eligible to apply if they secure 50% marks or equivalent grade (without adding grace mark) in the qualifying Degree Examination. Candidates belonging to these categories shall upload the certificates showing the eligibility and submit the photocopies of the same along with the print out of the application form.

Candidates awaiting results of their PG Examinations can also apply, but they shall qualify the PG Degree on or before 31.07.2018.

All the candidates who desire to apply for Ph.D. admission in the University Schools/Departments/Inter University Centres and approved Research Centres (except the categories noted below, who are exempted) have to appear for the Written Aptitude Test.

NB: Candidates who are <u>exempted</u> from appearing for WAT 2018 <u>need not apply now</u>. They need to apply directly for Ph.D registration when the notification is issued later.

Exemption from the Written Aptitude Test

The following categories of candidates are exempted from appearing for the Written Aptitude Test.

- a. JRF awardees.
- b. UGC Teacher Fellows
- c. M.Phil. & M.Tech. (all discipline), MD , MS, MDS (Modern Medicine, Homoeopathy and Ayurveda) Degree holders in the subject of research concerned.
- d. Regular and permanent teachers from the University Departments and the Government/Aided Colleges in Kerala.
- e. Candidates who have qualified in the NET/SLET/GATE/GPAT,JEST,RGNF or other tests conducted by such Government bodies as UGC,CSIR,ICAR/ICMR.
- f. DST Women Scientist Awardees
- g. KSCST/INSPIRE/MANF Fellowship Awardees
- h. Scientists from the Accredited R & D Institutions.

Fee for Application:

Candidates have to remit Rs.1,000/-(Rupees One Thousand Only) as application fee. For SC/ST candidates, the fee for application is Rs. 500/-(Rupees Five Hundred Only). The payment of the fee is allowed only through the Online Mode.

How to Apply

Candidates shall apply for the Written Aptitude Test 2018, Online, by accessing the University Website <u>www.phd.mgu.ac.in</u>. The Portal for Online registration for Written Aptitude Test 2018, will remain open from 24.04.2018, 10.00 am onwards to 15.05.2018, 5.00 pm. A copy of the print out of the Online application form along with the self attested photocopies of the documents uploaded shall be submitted to the Assistant Registrar XXI (Exams) , Mahatma Gandhi University, P.D. Hills – 686 560 on or before 16.05.2018, 3.00 pm.

- 6. Certificate from the Head of the Institution regarding the appearance of final P.G. Examination (for those awaiting P.G. Degree results)
- 7. Eligibility Certificate /Equivalency Certificate from Mahatma Gandhi University for candidates of Universities other than Mahatma Gandhi University.
