The clarifications to be attached to the Reified M.Ed. Curriculum, CBCSS, 2011-2012, regarding the grade and credit to be assigned to internship and Internal Evaluation.

Each teacher educand has to supervise the Internship Programme of a minimum of five B.Ed. students attached to a High school/ Higher Secondary School and should keep a separate observation record also. The teacher educand is expected to familiarise himself/ herself with the ongoing school practices including school administration, curricular and co-curricular activities that are being imparted in the institution.

Each teacher educand should take a minimum of five classes in a B.Ed. college either in common papers or in core papers or both taken together under the supervision of the Teacher educators. Each teacher educand has to keep a separate record for these activities.

The Board also recommended to provide a clarification for the credit for advanced practicum, that it is to be evaluated under internal evaluation and to be given a weigtage of one. In the reified curriculum, on page 9, under section 8.1 A Internal Evaluation has to be split to incorporate advanced practicum as,

d) Each student should take up a minimum of two items or do as per directions given in the section- Advanced practicum of each course.

In the reified curriculum, under course summary of the M.Ed programme, Semester II programme, the minimum contact hours given should be corrected and read as 108 for all the course which will give the total contact hours as 108 hours.

It is recommended to implement knowledge, and learning management (Code No.909.13) as an elective paper for the M.Ed. Degree programme under the M.G. University.
