iv. Marginal increase of seats sanctioned by the University over the affiliated strength shall not be included in the actual strength. Students admitted to marginal increase seats shall not be adjusted against vacancies that may arise within the sanctioned strength for this purpose

v. When a new college is affiliated/new course sanctioned, the workload of the first year of the course shall be calculated on the basis of affiliated student strength of the current academic year.
