
INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- 1. Application for admission to the examination together with the prescribed fee must be forwarded so as to reach the Controller of Examinations not later than the last date prescribed. The last date prescribed is the last date for receipt or application in the University and not for the remittance of fees.
- 2. Candidates are advised to send their application by Registered post with acknowledgement due, so that they may have a ready means of knowing that their applications have reached the office.
- 3. a) The fee for Examination is as follows:

Rs. 30/- Per Paper + and Rs. 20/- per paper as C.V. camp fee + Rs. 25/- for marklist

- b) The fees must be paid through Pay-in-slip at M.G. University Cash Counter friends Janasevanakendram or D.D. drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, M.G. University, payable at S.B.T., M.G. University Campus Branch code No. 669. No application will be registered unless the prescribed fee has been paid. The fee, once paid will not be refunded or held over for a subsequent examination.
- 4. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Christian converts from the Kudumbes etc. are eligible for exemption from payment of examination fee for their Second appearance should forward their applications through the Principals of the Colleges from where they were presented for the examination for the First time. INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

- 1. Candidates should take their seats in the examination hall at least five minutes before the commencement of the examination. Candidates presenting themselves more than half an hour after the appointed time will not be admitted to examination hall. Candidates who are undoubtedly suffering from infectious diseases of any kind will not be admitted. Candidates should bring with them their hall-ticket on each day of the examination and should produce the same when demanded for inspection by the Chief Supdt. or any other Asst. Supdt. or any otherperson authorised by the University for the purpose.
- 2. Candidates are prohibited from writing upon their hall-tickets or question papers. They are also prohibited from writing their names on any part of the answer books.

Candidates should write their register number in words as well as in figures in the space provided for the purpose on the outer cover of the answer book. (For eg. if the Reg. No. of candidate is 27389 the candidate shall write in letters "Two Seven Three Eight Nine") They are strictly prohibited from writing their register numbers on any other page of the answer books, Violation of this rule will invoke rejection of answer books.

- 3. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the expiry of at least half an hour after the question paper has been given and no candidate who leaves the room during the period allotted for the paper will be allowed to return within that period.
- Candidates are prohibited from introducing into the examination hall any books, mobile phone, paper or portion of book, slate, manuscript or paper of any description, from communicating with or copying from each other and from communicating with any person outside the examination hall. Any candidate detected in the violation of these Rules will be sent out of the hall forthwith and will not be permitted to sit for the remaining papers of the Examination.
 Violation of these rules may invoke cancellation of the examination taken by a candidate and his/her rustication for a period to be decided by the University.
- 5. When a candidate has finished writing his/her answer and wishes to hand over his/her answer book or at the end of the period prescribed for each particular part of the examination he/she shall stand up in his/her place and remain standing until one of the Superintendents has gone up to him/her and has received his/her answer book from him/her. He/she should not leave the hall leaving the answer book in his/her seat.
