1. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- i. Separate tender along with separate tender fee, separate EMD and separate sets of all other necessary documents should be submitted for each instrument. The main envelope should be superscribed: **TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF (ENTER NAME OF EQUIPMENT).** Last date of submission is 21thMarch 2019 and Date of Opening of Technical Bid: 22thMarch 2019, 11:00 A.M. at School of Biosciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam.
- ii. For those bidders submitting tenders for more than one instrument, separate applications for each instrument (Technical Bid and Financial Bid separately) must be placed in individual sealed envelopes and these envelopes must be placed inside a bigger envelope. Only one model can be quoted in a tender if the tenderer wants to quote for more than one model separate tenders with tender fee and EMD as required should be submitted. If more than one model is quoted in a single tender it will be summarily rejected.

- xiv. The tenders received late, without tender fee, without earnest money, without required documents or incomplete in any respect / Misleading will out rightly be rejected.
- xv. Other terms & conditions specific for different instruments must be complied with tender form.
- xvi. Financial bid and Technical compliance sheet for each instrument should be strictly as per tender format, and signed on each page.
- xvii. If the supplier/firm is manufacturer/authorized dealer/sole distributor of any item, the certificate to this effect should be attached.
- xviii. Availability of Spares: The tenderer must give certificate duly signed and stamped by manufacturer for the availability of spares and servicing of instrument for at least 10 years. Supplier should give an undertaking that spares/parts will be supplied within the specified periods as and when ordered.
- xix. Apart from all these terms and conditions, specific terms as specified for each instrument must also be complied.
- xx. Original catalogue (Do not put photocopies) as support documents for Specifications should be enclosed for verification. In case such documents are not submitted the statements of the tenderer in regards to specification of equipments will not be accepted and will be rejected.

4. OPENING OF TENDERS

- i. Unless otherwise preponed, or postponed with advance intimation to the tenderers, tender will be opened in two stages at School of Biosciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, Priyadarshini Hills P.O, Kottayam – 686 560, Kerala, India on the date and time indicated in first page of the instruction sheet of this tender document.
- ii. TENDER FORM PART-I (TECHNICAL BID) of the tender will be opened at the first stage on the due date and at time indicated for opening in the instruction sheet of this tender document while the TENDER FORM PART-II (FINANCIAL BID) will be opened at the second stage on the due date and time indicated for opening in the instruction sheet of this tender document after completion of the evaluation of the Technical part (Part-I) of the tender.
- iii. While all the tenderers who submit tenders within the due date and time specified for its receipt will be permitted to participate in the opening of PART-I (TECHNICAL BID) of the tender on the due date and time indicated in the instruction sheet of this tender document, opening of the PART-II (FINANCIAL BID) of the tender can be attended to only by such of those tenderers whose tenders are found to be technically suitable/acceptable to the technical committee and to whom intimation thereof is given by the Purchaser by Fax/Telegram/Letter/e-mail/phone etc

- vi. The tenderer's representative, who reaches the venue of the tender opening late, i.e. after the starting time specified for opening of the tenders, will not be allowed to take part in the tender opening. **It should be noted that only one representative of each tenderer will be permitted to participate in the tender opening.**

5. EVALUATION OF BIDS RECEIVED:

- i. The technical and purchase committee of BIIC Funded Research Project has the full right to evaluate, segregate, rank the responsive bids and select the successful bidder for placement of the contract. Any decision by the technical and purchase committee in this regard will be final.
- ii. No legally enforceable right is vested in the quoted party merely because it was ostensibly the lowest bidder

6. BID SECURITY

- i. Earnest money of 2.5 percent of the estimated value will be taken from the prospective bidders in case of limited/advertised tender in the form of Account payee Demand Draft, Bankers cheque or a Bank Guarantee from a commercial bank. Suppliers registered with Director General of Supplies & Disposals (DGS&D), National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Govt. approved sources are exempted. Tender without EMD will be considered unresponsive and rejected.

7. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

- i. For contracts above value of Rs.1.00 lakh, performance security of 10 percent of the value of contract is to be obtained from the successful bidder, awarded the contract, in the form of Bank Guarantee or Fixed

Deposit (with a lien to The Principal Investigator, BIIC Funded Research Project, School of Biosciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam) from a commercial bank which should be valid for a period of 60 days beyond the completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including warranty. Performance security will be forfeited and credited to the Institute in the event of breach of contractual obligation by the supplier, in terms of relevant contract

- ii. Bid Security will be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of performance security. The institute/ Principal Investigator will pay no interest for the deposit.

8. DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND WORK COMPLETION

- i. The delivery of the material will be made within stipulated time period as given in the supply/work award letter otherwise will attract penalty. In case of imported item, the supplier/their Indian Agent will be responsible for delivery of the material from the place of discharge of material to final point (School of Biosciences, Mahatma Gandhi University Campus, Priyadarshini Hills PO, Athirampuzha, Kottayam).

9. PRICE AND DELIVERY

- i. Prices are to be quoted **F.O.R DESTINATION** (to the room assigned for BIIC Funded Research Project at School of Biosciences, MG University). The prices quoted should clearly indicate the following charges: Price of the equipment including accessories; Customs duty (after submission of custom and excise exemption certificate if applicable); Customs Clearance Charges and transportation charges if applicable. If these details are not provided it will be considered that the price quoted is inclusive of all charges.
- ii. The prices quoted must be FIRM and preference will be given to such tenders. In exceptional cases (e.g. items involving substantial use of raw materials susceptible to sharp fluctuation in prices) if prices are quoted subject to variation it shall be on the basis of a standard Price Variation Formula. The basis for calculation shall be very clearly stated. Here again preference will be given to the tenders with a specific ceiling on escalation.
- iii. All other charges including GST, Excise Duty and other levies payable by **F.O.R DESTINATION** (Room assigned for BIIC Funded Research Project at school of Biosciences, MG University) should be clearly indicated otherwise it will be presumed that the rates quoted are inclusive of all these charges and will not be paid.
- iv. Essentiality certificate will also be provided to selected tenderes so the price can be quoted at reduced GST rate as per government guidelines.
- v. The Excise Duty component (with percentage) should be indicated, as the University is exempted from the payment of Custom/Excise Duty. Exemption will be availed by providing Custom/Excise Duty Exemption Certificate with order.
- vi. The Delivery Schedule, Payment Terms & Warranty/Guarantee etc must be clearly indicated in the technical bid. The charges for extended warranty and/or Annual Maintenance Contract after the expiry of offered warranty period should also be specified in the financial bid.

- i. Warranty for the instrument as well as accessories will be for 3 years (36 months) from the date of installation and no cost will be paid for service /repair/spares during warranty period. Any defective goods supplied should be replaced or repaired by the supplier free of charge. Delivery of goods and its installation at School of Biosciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam during part repair/replacement should be free of charge during the period of warranty. A warranty certificate declaring these points must be supplied with the technical bid.

12. MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

The instrument or machinery is to be maintained free of charge by the supplier during warranty period (3 years) or such other extended periods as the contract terms may provide and the paid maintenance should commence only thereafter. If the supplier fails to deliver the goods and / or perform the services within the contractual delivery period for reasons other than circumstances beyond supplier's control (which will be determined by the purchaser) and the purchaser extends the delivery period, the purchaser will also deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to 0.5% (half percent) of the delivered, being the price of the delayed goods or unperformed services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance. The maximum limit of such deduction will, however, be 10% (ten percent) of the contract price of the delayed goods or services.

13. SALES TAX REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE
