The following schedule is approved for admission to **B.Ed Special Education (Intellectual Disability) and B.Ed Special Education (Learning Disability)** Degree Programmes for the academic year 2019-21 offered at Training Colleges for Special Education affiliated to this University.

The Principals, Training Colleges for Special Education affiliated to this University are directed to comply with the above schedule of admission to B.Ed Special Education (Intellectual Disability) and B.Ed Special Education (Learning Disability) Degree programmes for the academic year 2019-21.

Eligibility

Eligibility for admission, norms for admission and reservation of seats for B.Ed Special Education Programme shall be according to the rules framed by the University and Government from time to time for the general B.Ed Programme.

1. B.Ed Special Education (Intellectual Disability)

Candidates who have passed any graduate level degree examination which is recognized by Mahatma Gandhi University with 50 % aggregate marks or equivalent grade (CGPA of 2) are eligible for admission. SC/ST candidates need only a minimum pass in the qualifying examination. Candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Communities (SEBC) will be given 3% concession in aggregate marks. Candidates who are parents or siblings of children with mental retardation will be given 3% concession in aggregate marks. Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities (OEC) will be given 5% concession in aggregate marks. The reservation of seats for the programme shall be according to rules. Candidates with a Bachelors Degree in any branch of Disability Studies (BMR/BRS/BRSC.etc) and a Master's degree in Disability Studies with Mental Retardation (Intellectual Disability) as elective subject are eligible for a weightage of 5% marks. Candidates with a minimum of 5 years teaching experience after taking Diploma in Special Education Mental Retardation(Intellectual Disability) are eligible for a relaxation of 5% marks.

2. B.Ed Special Education (Learning Disability)

Candidates who have passed any graduate level degree examination which is recognized by Mahatma Gandhi University with 50% aggregate marks or equivalent grade (CGPA of 2) are eligible for admission. SC/ST candidates need only a minimum pass in the qualifying examination.

Candidates with Master's Degree in Disability Studies with Learning Disability as elective subject are eligible for a weightage of 5% marks.

Duration

(i) The duration of B.Ed Special Education Programme shall be four semesters spread over two years.

(ii) The Duration of each semester shall be of 100 days spread over 20 working weeks.

(iii) A student may be permitted to complete the programmes, on valid reasons, within a period of six semesters from the date of commencement of the first semester of the programme.(B.Ed Special Education (Intellectual Disability))

(iv) A student may be permitted to complete the programme, on valid reasons, within a period of 3 years from the date of admission to the programme (B.Ed Special Education(Learning Disability))

(v) The duration of odd semesters shall be from June to October and that of even Semesters from November to March. There shall be 3 days semester break after odd semesters and 2 months vacation during April and May in every academic year.

(vi) Readmission: Those candidates who discontinue the course can be given the provision of readmission if otherwise eligible as long as the same scheme exists. If there is a change in the scheme anytime later, candidate will have to join the course as a fresh entrant if otherwise eligible.

Medium of Instruction and examination

The medium of instruction and examination of the course shall be in English.

General Instructions

- The list of students admitted to the course under merit, SC/ST and other reservation quotas indicating the actual marks secured and index marks arrived at should be forwarded to this office on or before 16.09.2019.
- Candidates who have passed qualifying examinations from other Universities/Institutions and not approved by the University shall not be admitted unless Eligibility Certificates are produced.
- The Principals are directed to admit students within the sanctioned strength only. It is mandatory to send memo cards, intimating the date of interview, to all those who figure in the rank list, under Registered Post with Acknowledgement due.
- Seats reserved for SC/ST category should be re-notified twice if such seats are remaining vacant.
- All items of fee due to the University should be remitted to the University account within 30 days after the closing of admission.
