ELIGIBILITY

A pass in any Bachelor's Degree Examination of Mahatma Gandhi University or an equivalent degree of any other Universities duly recognized by M.G University with not less than 55% marks in Science and Technology subjects and 50% marks in other subjects in the aggregate for all parts of examinations OR a Master's Degree examination with 55% marks in aggregate. (Only a pass in any Bachelor's Degree examination is needed for SC/ST candidates).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The rank list for admission shall be prepared on the basis of Entrance examination, Group Discussion and Personal Interview. The weightage shall be 70% for Entrance examination,15% for Group Discussion and 15% for Personal Interview. The Reservation Rules are applicable as per the Government norms.

- The list of candidates admitted to the above MHRM course under merit, SC/ST and other reservation quotas indicating the actual marks secured and index marks arrived at, should be forwarded to this office on or before 30.08.2019
- Candidates who have passed qualifying examinations from other Universities/Institutions and not approved by the University shall not be admitted unless eligibility certificates are produced.
- Candidates belonging to SEBC and OEC are allowed a concession of 3%&5% marks respectively in the prescribed minimum marks for admission to the above programme.
- A relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination from the prescribed minimum is allowed for differently abled candidates.
- The Principals are directed to admit students within the sanctioned strength only. No admission shall be made in anticipation of enhancement of seats.
- It is mandatory to send memo cards, intimating the dates of interviews, to all those who figure in the rank list, under registered post with acknowledgement due.
- Seats reserved for SC/ST and other reservation categories should be re-notified twice if such seats are remaining vacant.
- All items of fees due to the University should be remitted to the University account within 30 days after the closing of admission.
