It is hereby notified that the following amendment to "*Mahatma Gandhi University Regulations relating to Revaluation and Scrutiny of Answer scripts*", clauses 14 and 15 has been approved by the Vice-Chancellor exercising powers of Academic Council under Section 10(17) of the Mahatma Gandhi University Act, 1985. This amendment shall come into force with immediate effect.
