ORDER

The following guidelines were followed for determining merit in sports quota admission to Under Graduate programmes . Marks were awarded to the First (Winner or Winning Team), Second (Runner up or Runner up Team), Third (third place) and for participation. Minimum eligibility for admission of a candidate to undergraduate programmes (Sports Quota) is representation of a sub district in the Educational District Sports Competition in addition to his/her satisfying academic eligibility. But the mark points for the participation of Sub District competition were not included in the Table 3-1 UG Prospectus for 2018 admission.

In the above matter, the Director, School of Physical Education Sports and Sciences has forwarded the revised norms, for UG Sports Quota Admissions 2019-20 onwards. The revised norms are applicable for UG sports quota admission including readmission, and are given in the table mentioned below

 - 3.Upper age limit for applying for Sports Quota will be 25 Years
