O R D E R

The Principal, Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Technology, Pampady has forwarded a request received from a physically handicapped candidate studying for S-III Electrical & Electronics of B.Tech Degree course. He has requested that the benefit of granting special concession have to be made applicable to the whole exams of a course instead of giving sanction to semesterwise or yearwise to those candidates who are permanently disabled.

The request was considered by the University and the Syndicate as per decision No. 12 (addl.item) dated 21.1.'99 resolved to grant extra time of 15 minutes per hour to physically handicapped candidates having permanent nature of disability and who cannot freely use their hands with normal speed. The Syndicate has also resolved that such concession be granted for all the examinations of the entire course for candidates having permanent disability in writing and who could not write with normal speed.

Conditions for granting special concession to physically handicapped candidates at the various University examinations:

1. The applications should be accompanied with a Medical Certificate from a specialist concerned together with the photograph of the candidate
2. The photograph must show the actual handicap or defect of the candidate and it should be attested by the Medical Officer.
3. Attested copy of the Medical Certificate will not be accepted.
4. The application should be submitted through the concerned Principal.
5. Extra time will be granted only to candidates who are actually handicapped/disabled.
6. The Medical certificates will be returned to candidates after the examinations are over.
7. The application alongwith the medical certificate and the photograph of the candidate should be submitted 2 months before the commencement of the examination.
