ORDER

The University has exempted the Deaf and Dumb candidates from studying Second Language for Pre-Degree and Degree Courses, if they desire so, vide UO read (1) above.

Consequently on the introduction of CBCSS programme effective from 2009 admission onwards the deaf and dumb candidates who are exempted from appearing the Second Language examinations cannot attain the minimum credits of 120 required for successful completion of the course. The Monitoring Committee held on 11/03/2011 discuss the matter in detail and recommended that the grades of deaf, dumb and dyslexic candidates, who are exempted from writing the second language examinations be calculated proportionately to the University average of the second language taken by the candidate.

Sanction has been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor for the approval of the above recommendations of the University level Monitoring Committee held on 11/03/2011 by exercising powers under Chapter 3.10(17) of the Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985.
