O R D E R

As per the decision of the Academic Council meeting read as (1) above, it has been resolved to award grace marks of 25% of total marks of theory papers of all University examinations including Professional Examinations attempted by deaf or deaf & dumb candidates having disability of 40% or more subject to the following rules:

1. The candidates must produce a Medical Certificate from the Medical Board, to prove that he/she is hearing impaired with a loss of 50 decibels or more in the better ear in conversational range of frequencies.
2. The grace marks shall be awarded at the time of the finalisation of the results of each part only.
3. While awarding grace marks no transfer of marks will be permitted from one subject/part to another.
4. While adding the grace marks, the total marks of a paper shall be limited to 90% only.
5. The grace marks will be awarded before effecting moderation if any.
6. The grace marks thus awarded will not be considered for ranking/scholarship.
7. The sum of marks, if any, arrived at while computing 25% grace marks will be ignored.
