Requirements

I. Computer system:

The computer system used for applying online should have the following facilities a)Internet – should have an internet connection

b)Browser – should have a browser, Recommended browsers are Mozilla

Firefox,Google Chrome and Internet Explorer only.

c) Pdf reader – should have a pdf reader like, Adobe pdf reader or foxit reader.

d)Printer – the printout of all pages of application should be taken in laser printer /inkjet printer in A4 **white paper only**.

II. Email ID:

Candidate should posses a valid email id. Keep this Email id live and secure till the end of the admission process, PG Private Registration 2019. If you do not have an email id, a new email id must be created before applying online. Candidate should not provide the email id to others, under any circumstances. a. Single Registration under Semester Scheme

g. Matriculation

Candidates, who have been matriculated under this University at present, need not apply for further matriculation. Candidates who have not matriculated in this University shall apply for such registration in the prescribed form paying the prescribed fee. In such cases, both the matriculation fee and private registration fee should be remitted through Integrated Online Payment System. Candidates who have already obtained migration certificate from this University and wish to apply for private registration should re-matriculate in this University by paying the prescribed fee and submitting the application for matriculation along with the Migration certificate.

h. Recognition

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state shall be required to apply for recognition of the qualifying examination passed by them, in the prescribed form paying the prescribed fee. Such candidates applying for recognition of the qualifying examination shall submit along with their application, the qualifying certificate, migration certificate and eligibility certificate. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Universities within the State of Kerala are exempted from individual recognition if the examination passed by them is recognised by this University. However, they have to produce a No Objection Certificate / Migration Certificate from the Universities concerned.

i. Eligibility Certificate (through online only)

V. SCHEME & SYLLABI AT A GLANCE

The Post Graduate Programmes under Credit Semester System (MGU-PG-CSS2019) shall come into force from the Academic Year 2019-2020 onwards.

The regulation shall apply to all Private post-graduate programmes with effect from the academic year 2019-2020 admission onwards with suitable modifications for Private Study.

<u>Eligibility for Admissions</u> Academic eligibility should be satisfied as on the date of notification.

A SEPARATE COURSE / PROGRAMME IN LIEU OF PROJECT / DISSERTATION

In lieu of the course 'Project / Dissertation' offered in the IV Semester for the Regular Mode, a separate course/programme shall be included for students undergoing Private Study.

END-SEMESTER EXAMINATION

For private stream (From 2019 Admission onwards), semester wise examinations along with regular (college) students shall be conducted from Second Semester onwards. A separate examination, along with the second semester examination, shall be conducted for the First Semester Private Students alone.

INTERNAL EVALUATION

The evaluation scheme for each course shall contain two parts; (a) External Evaluation and (b) Internal Evaluation

There will be no internal evaluation component in the Scheme of Examination for private students. The Marks secured by them for the theory examination (Maximum marks-75) will be computed proportionately to 100 in order to maintain uniformity.

ELECTIVE COURSES AND GROUPS

The number of Elective Groups for PG PRIVATE COURSES (EXCEPT M.Com) shall be limited in Private Mode. Only one Elective Group comprising of three courses each for a programme is permitted and these elective courses shall be included either in IV Semester or be distributed among III and IV Semesters.

A student who has registered for the programme shall <u>complete the programme</u> <u>within a period of four years</u> from the date of commencement of the programme.

Students are eligible to pursue studies for **additional Post Graduate Degree**. They shall be eligible for award of degree only after successful completion of two years (four semesters of study) either as college going student or through private study.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for admission to the first semester of the PG programme through CSS shall be required to have passed an appropriate Degree Examination of Mahatma Gandhi University as specified or any other examination of any recognized University or authority accepted by the Academic council of Mahatma Gandhi University as eligible thereto.
