ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited for admission to the BBA LL.B.(Hons) Programme of the **School** of Indian Legal Thought, Mahatma Gandhi University, Suryakalady Hills, Nattasserry, S.H. Mount P.O., Kottayam – 686 006, Kerala . for the Academic year 2020-21.

Details of the Programmes and Duration: These regular Programmes lead to the BBA LL.B.(Hons). The Programme extends for a period of ten Semesters. Registration for examination shall be based on attendance and the progress of the candidate.

Eligibility: Pass in Higher Secondary or +2 Examination recognized by Mahatma Gandhi University or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with not less than 45% marks in aggregate.

For SC/ST applicants and ST applicants of Lakshadweep, only a pass minimum is required and for SEBC and OEC applicants 3% and 5% relaxation of marks respectively are allowed.

Age limit: The candidate should be below 20 years of age as on 1St July of the year concerned. One year relaxation in upper age limit is admissible for SC/ST, SEBC and OEC applicants.

Sanctioned Strength of Seats: 50

SELECTION PROCESS:


Selection of students is based on the marks secured in the Entrance Test. The Entrance Test shall be of **1 hour 30 minutes** duration carrying 100 marks and is intended to test the General Knowledge, Logical Reasoning, Language skills, Legal Aptitude etc.. of the candidates.

The applicants who have obtained 10,+2 or graduation through Open University System directly without having any basic qualifications for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission to law programmes.

RESERVATION OF SEATS:

1. Reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PD): 5% of the seats are reserved for







candidates with disabilities for all programmes. Seats shall be equally reserved for each of the three sections of **Persons with Disabilities category** (**Blind, Deaf and Orthopaedically Challenged**) as over and above sanctioned strength and if candidates are not available in a particular category, the seats shall not be filled from any other categories. The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-se merit list and physical suitability, and not on the basis of the degree of disability. 'Person with disability' means a person suffering from not less than 40% of any disability as certified by a Medical Board constituted for this purpose. Candidates who have a minimum of 40% disability alone will be eligible for this quota. A relaxation of 5% of marks in the qualifying examination from the prescribed minimum is allowed. Candidates seeking admission under PD category should upload with their application form, an attested copy of the 'Certificate of disability' issued by a District Medical Board or bodies of higher status, certifying the degree or percentage of disability.

2. Mandatory Reservation:

The break-up of mandatory reservation will be as follows:

3. BONUS MARKS

- a. Bonus of 15 marks shall be awarded to applicants with NCC or NSS Certificates at 'Plus Two Level' for admission to all programmes. In respect of NCC candidates, the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of NCC Certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC to candidates who have secured al least 75% attendance after having participated in its activities during the programme of study immediately preceding the programme for which admission is sought. An additional bonus mark of 5 to 'B' Certificate holders in proof of their high proficiency.
- b. In respect of NSS candidates, the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of NSS Certificates issued by the competent authority.
- c. Bonus of 15 marks shall be awarded to the Ex-servicemen applicants and widows and children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen seeking admission to the Degree Programmes. Applicants to this category should invariably produce along with the application form an attested copy of certificate issued not earlier than six months from the last date of submission of application from the military authorities or state/Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter of an ex-service man or an ex service man himself/herself.

4. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a. All those who possess the approved minimum qualification are eligible to apply.
- b. Only the Programmes and their equivalents approved by the Mahatma Gandhi University shall be reckoned as eligible qualification.
- c. CANDIDATES AWAITING FINAL YEAR RESULTS CAN ALSO APPLY FOR THESE PROGRAMMES, PROVIDED THEY PRODUCE THEIR MARKLISTS AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION.
- d. No rounding of percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is permitted.

5. Application fee:

For General candidates: Rs. 600/-

For SC/ST candidates: Rs. 300/-

Application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstance.

HOW TO APPLY:

- a. For online registration of personal and academic data, the candidates must visit the web site, http://cat.mgu.ac.in/BBALLB and follow the instructions
- b. The filled up application form should be complete in all respects. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.

Documents to be produced at the time of admission

- a. Original documents to prove qualification/age/caste and other relevant certificates should be produced at the time of admission
- b. Those who have qualified from Boards (excluding CBSE,ICSE) outside Kerala State should produce eligibility/recognition certificate from this University, and those who have qualified from Boards(including CBSE,ICSE) should produce Migration Certificate from parent Board.

If an applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she had indulged in ragging, admissions shall be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the educational institution.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed that if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the student concerned shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the institution.
