INTER-DISCIPLINARY AND TRANS-DISCIPLINARY EDUCATION: APPROACHES AND REFLECTIONS

Interdisciplinarity combines two or more disciplines to a new level of integration, forcing the suggested conventional component boundaries of disciplines to break down. Trans-disciplinarity occurs when two or more discipline perspectives transcend each other to form a new holistic approach. Transcending disciplinary boundaries are becoming increasingly important for devising solutions to the world's most pressing issues. Institutions of higher education often face challenges on teaching students how to work and innovate in transdisciplinary themes. The School of Pedagogical Sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, encourage inter as well as trans-disciplinary approaches to teaching and learning across all programmes and courses of study. The central idea of the approach is to educate students in the exploration and utilization of diverse approaches to critical thinking and to participatory and interactive learning so that they authentically make connections among multiple disciplines, work jointly with students from other Schools on an area of common interest, co-create knowledge, construct their own meaning and transfer the learning to real world applications. Multidisciplinary study provides opportunity to choose from a wide range of subjects, allowing learning in diverse ways.

This webinar identifies and explains the importance of inter-disciplinary and trans-disciplinary studies. It aims to provide the participants a unique opportunity to understand the significance of inter-disciplinary and trans-disciplinary study in a wider perspective, and how to apply it in different contexts and real-life scenario. It will also help in appreciating the connections between various subjects of study and to transfer knowledge beyond subject boundaries. It is in this spirit that the School of Pedagogical Sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University, Kerala, India has collaborated with the Directorate of Minority Welfare, Government of Kerala and conceived this webinar on Inter-disciplinary and Transdisciplinary Education.
