ELIGIBILITY

A pass in any Bachelor's Degree Examination of Mahatma Gandhi University or an equivalent degree of any other University duly recognized by Mahatma Gandhi University with not less than 55% marks in Science and Technology subjects and 50% marks in other subjects in the aggregate for all parts of examinations OR a Master's Degree examination with 55% marks in aggregate. (Only a pass in any Bachelor's Degree examination is needed for SC/ST candidates).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The rank list for admission shall be prepared on the basis of marks in the Qualifying examination. Entrance examination, Group Discussion and Personal Interview are waived **ONLY** for this year (2020) considering the pandemic situation.

The Reservation Rules are applicable as per the University norms.
