Eligibility criteria for new generation interdisciplinary programmes

Program: Integrated MA English
Eligibility Criteria:

Same as eligibility criteria for BA English (Regular) Programme in colleges affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University

Program: Integrated MSc Programme in Basic Sciences (Physics)
Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates need to pass Plus Two examination or its equivalent qualification, with Physics as one of the main subjects, from any recognized education board.

## Programme: Integrated MSc Programme in Basic Sciences (Chemistry) Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates need to pass Plus Two examination or its equivalent qualification, with Chemistry as one of the main subjects, from any recognized education board.

Programme: Integrated MSc Programme in Basic Sciences (Biology) Eligibility Criteria:

1) Candidated need to pass Plus Two examination or its equivalent qualification, with Biology as one of the main subjects, from any recognized education board.
2) Candidates who have passed Plus Two in Vocational stream (VHSE/Technical Plus Two) with agriculture and allied Biosciences as major subjects, from any recognized education board.

Programme: MSc Industrial Chemistry
Eligibility Criteria:

1) Candidates who have passed BSc Chemistry (Model I, Model II or Model III) programme in CBCSS (2009) pattern or CBCSS (2013/2017) patterns.
2) Candidates who have passed BSc Chemistry or BSc Industrial Chemistry or BSc degree in any other stream of Chemical Sciences.
3) BSc Industrial Chemistry graduates will be awarded with a weightage of $10 \%$ marks for index mark calculation.

## Programme: MSc Computer Science with Data Analysis

Eligibility Criteria:

A regular BSc. Degree with Mathematics / Computer Science / Electronics as one of the subjects (Main or Subsidiary) OR BCA / B. Tech degree with not less than 55\% marks in optional subjects.

Candidates with degree in Computer Science / Computer Application / IT /
Electronics shall be given a weightage of $20 \%$ in their qualifying degree examination marks considered for ranking for admission to MSc Computer Science with Data Analytics.

Programme: Integrated MSc Computer Science (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning)
Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates need to pass Plus Two examination or its equivalent qualification, with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as main subjects, from any recognized education board.

Programme: Integrated MSc in Computer Science (Data Science)
Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates need to pass Plus Two examination or its equivalent qualification, with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as main subjects, from any recognized education board.

Weightage of 5\% marks scored by the candidate in Part III Core/Main shall be added to the total of Part III Core / Main for those candidates who have studied BSc

Statistics (Core / Main) after standardizing the marks secured for the same to 600.

Programme: MA Business Economics
Eligibility Criteria:

A pass in BA Economics or BSc (Mathematics) degree examination of Mahatma Gandhi University or from other University recognized by the syndicate of the Mahatma Gandhi University as equivalent thereto.

Programme: Bachelor of Financial Markets<br>Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates who have passed Plus Two of Higher Secondary Board of Kerala or from any Board recognized as equivalent thereto, with Book Keeping and Accountancy and any two of the following subjects are eligible to apply.
(1) Commerce (2) Commercial Correspondence and Commercial Geography (3)

Economics (4) Life Insurance with Salesmanship (5) Banking with Secretarial Practice (6) Business Studies (7) Mathematics (8) Computer Science (9) Computer Application (10) Informatics Practice and (11) Management as optional under Part III of the Examination.

## OR

Have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination recognized by this University with other subjects under Part III optional, provided they have secured 45\% aggregate marks or an examination accepted by the University as equivalent thereto, subject to restrictions regarding marks mentioned above. Relaxation in marks allowed for SC / ST, OEC, SEBC and Physically Challenged candidates, as prescribed by University from time to time.

## Programme: Bachelor of Sports Management (BSM) <br> Eligibility Criteria:

Candidate shall be required to have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto by Mahatma Gandhi University.

Applicant should not have any medical, physical or mental disability which prevents him/her from actively taking part in physical activities.

The Bonus Marks will be awarded as follows:

1. Bonus of 15 marks shall be awarded to applicants with sports participation certificate of least Revenue district level competition at Plus Two Level for admission to Bachelor of Sports Management (BSM).
2. Bonus of 15 marks shall be awarded to applicants with NCC or NSS Certificate at Plus Two Level for admission to BSM. In Respect of NCC candidates, the bonus marks will be awarded on the basic of NCC Certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC to candidates who have secured at least 75\% attendance after having participated in its activities during the programme of study immediately preceding the programme for which admission is sought. An additional bonus mark of 5 to 'B' Certificate holders in proof of their high proficiency.
3. In respect of NSS Volunteers, the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of NSS Certificates issued by the competent authority.
4. Bonus of 15 marks shall be awarded to Ex-servicemen applicants and widows and children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen seeking admission to the Degree Programme. Applicants in this category should product along with the application form an attested copy of certificate issued not earlier than six months from the last date of submission of application from the military authorities or state / Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that he / she is the son / daughter of an ex-service man or an ex-service man himself / herself.

The benefit of bonus marks can be scored by a candidate only under one category i.e. either Sports, NSS or NCC. Bonus marks shall be added only if the candidate has obtained the prescribed minimum qualifying marks in the qualifying examination while calculating the index marks.

Handicap Mark/s shall not be deemed as marks awarded for physical / mental
disability of any kind of the applicant concerned. Handicap mark is the mark deducted from the marks of an applicant on account of acquiring the eligible qualifications in subsequent chances following the regular chance in which he or she ought to have acquired the eligible qualification.

## Indexing of Marks

Marks obtained in Part III of qualifying examination less handicap marks plus bonus marks if any with 50\% quota for science Group and 50\% quota for Arts and Commerce Group and if not filled up from one quota the rest can be filled from other quota.

Programme: MSc Data Analytics
Eligibility Criteria:

BSc Degree with Mathematics / Statistics / Data Science as a core subject or B. Tech / B.E. in Computer Science / IT or Bachelor of Computer Applications, provided the candidate has studies at least two courses in Probability / Statistics at degree level.

Programme: Integrated MS in Basic Sciences - Statistics
Eligibility Criteria:

1) Candidates need to pass Plus-Two examination or its equivalent qualification from any recognized education board.
2) Candidates must have passed Plus Two examination with mathematics as one of their main subject.

Programme: M.Sc. Statistics Applied Algorithms, Statistical Techniques in Data Mining, Analysis of Multi-type Data, Statistical Modelling, Non-parametric Statistics

Eligibility Criteria:

1) Graduates who have passed qualifying examination in CBCSS (2009) pattern


#### Abstract

BSc degree in Statistics or Mathematics main or BSc (triple main) with Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science with CGPA not less than 2.00 out of 4 in the Core Group (Core + Complementary + Open Courses).


Or
2) Graduates who have passed qualifying examination in CBCSS (2013/2017) pattern

BSc degree in Statistics or Mathematics main or BSC (triple main) with Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science with not less than CCPA or 5.00 out of 10.00 in the Core Group (Core + Complementary + Open Courses).

3 Graduates who have passed qualifying examination in other patterns

BSc Degree in Statistics or Mathematics main or BSc (triple main) with mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science with not less than $50 \%$ marks in the Part III subjects (Main / Core + Subsidiaries / Complementary Courses).

Weightage

Weightage of $5 \%$ marks scored by the candidate in Part III Core / Main shall be added to the total of Part III Core / Main for those candidates who have studies BSc Statistics (Core / Main) after standardizing the marks secured for the same to 600.

## Programme: Master of Commerce and Management Eligibility:

Admission to Master of Commerce and Management Programme shall be open only to candidates who have passed B.Com / BBA / BBM / BFM / any otehr degree programme awarded under the discipline of commerce or management approved by M.G. University with a minimum of $45 \%$ of aggregrate marks. Relaxation in percentage of marks is allowed for SCIST, OEC, SEBC and Physically Challenged
students as prescribed by University from time to time．
