1. Every column of the application should be carefully filled in by the candidate.
2. Applications for admission to the examination together with the S. B. T. pay in slip must be forwarded so as to reach the Controller of Examinations not later than the last date prescribed. The last date prescribed is the date for receipt of application in the University and not for remittance of fees.
3. APPLICATIONS WHICH ARE DEFECTIVE IN ANY RESPECT, INCOMPLETE AND THOSE RECEIVED AFTER THE LAST DATE PRESCRIBED WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED.
4. The application shall be forwarded through the Director of the Department / Centre / School where the candidate has studied.
5. Exam fees for all M. Phil Programmes except M. Phil in Education conducted by various Schools under the University - Rs. 375/-+Rs. 25/- as fee for marklist per semester and for M. Phil in Education 1) Theory - Rs. 500/- 2) Dissertation / Viva-voce - Rs. 500/- 3) Marklist - Rs. 25/-.
6. The fee must be paid in the University Cash Counter in a duplicate chalan to the credit of the Mahatma Gandhi University Fund Account. Chalan from any branch of SBT, in favour of Finance Officer, M. G. University, payable at MGU Campus Branch of SBT will be registered unless the prescribed fee has been paid. The fee once paid will not be refunded or held over for a subsequent examination.
7. The mark list of all candidates will be sent to the Director of the Department / School where the candidate appear for the examination.
8. The marklist of candidates who fail to produce the Original Qualifying Certificate and Qualifying Marklists at the Uty. Office for verification, will not be released.
9. If the candidate has passed the qualifying examination from a University outside the state he/she should obtain recognition of the qualifying examination from this University.

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS**

Candidates should take their places in the examination hall at least five minutes before the Commencement of the examination. Candidates presenting themselves more than half an hour after the appointed time will not be admitted to examination hall. Candidates who are undoubtedly suffering from infectious diseases of any kind will not be admitted. Candidates should bring with them to the examination hall, each day of the examination their hall tickets for inspection by the Chief Superintendent.

Candidates are prohibited from writing upon their hall-tickets or question papers. They are also prohibited from writing their names on any part of the answer books.

**Candidate should write their register number in words as well as in figures in the space provided for the purpose on the outer cover of the answer book. (For e.g., - if the Reg. No. of the Candidate is 27389 the candidate shall write in letters Two seven Three Eight Nine) They are strictly prohibited from writing their register numbers on any other page of their answer books. Violation of this Rule will involve rejection of answer books.**

No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the expiry of at least half an hour after question paper has been supplied and no candidate who leaves the room during the period allotted for a paper, will be allowed to return within that period.

Candidates are prohibited from introducing into the examination hall any book or portion of book, slate, manuscript or paper of any description, from communicating with or copying from each other and from communicating with any person outside the examination room. Any candidate detected in the violation of these Rules will be sent out of the hall forthwith and will not be permitted to sit for the remaining papers of the Examination. Violation of these rules may involve cancellation of the examination taken by a candidate and his/her rustication for a period to be decided by the University.

When a candidate has finished writing his/her answers and wishes to return his/her answer books or at the end of the period prescribed for each particular part of the examination he/she shall stand up in his/her place and remain standing until one of the superintendents has gone up to him/her and has received his/her answer book from him/her. He/she should not leave the hall leaving the answer book in his/her seat.
