ORDER

The Budget 2021-22 of the University proposed setting up of an International Centre for Polar Studies (ICPS), a polar co-operation centre of both science and social sciences. This centre is proposed to function with the support of National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research (NCPOR), Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India. ICPS is intended to support a multi-level sustainable approach of attaining environmentally and socially responsible development. The centre also envisages to act as a consultant in geopolitical policies and human ecological aspects for the Government of India

The Pro Vice Chancellor vide paper read (2) above, had proposed constitution of a General advisory Committee, Academic advisory Committee, Executive Committee and the Centre Administration set up for the centre.
