3. FACULTY OF SCIENCE (M.Sc.)

12. M.Sc. Mathematics Graduates in Mathematics or Statistics as Optional/Main/Core Courses under Part III with 45% marks for Part III or 1.8 Grade Point in Mathematics under CBCSS Core Group or B.Tech Graduates (Except B.Tech Lateral Entry) with not less than 45% marks for Mathematics (aggregate of all the 4 papers of Mathematics) and a total of 45% marks for the entire course or Graduates in B.Sc. Computer Application with not less than 45% of marks in the optional subjects concerned including Computer Application and Statistics/1.8 Grade Point in Computer Application under CBCSS Stream. Candidates belonging to SC/ST are exempted from minimum marks restriction and OBC will be allowed a concession of 2% of marks. Bonafied teachers employed on the date of application in Govt./Aided Schools in the Kerala State shall be exempted from the minimum marks required, on production of an employment certificate from the AEO/DEO/Principal concerned.

END-SEMESTER EXAMINATION

For private stream(From 2019 Admission onwards), semester wise examinations along with regular (college)students shall be conducted from Second Semester onwards. A separate examination, along with the second semester examination, shall be conducted for the First Semester Private Students alone.

INTERNAL EVALUATION

There will be no internal evaluation component in the Scheme of Examination for private students. The Marks secured by them for the theory examination (Maximum marks-75) will be computed proportionately to 100 in order to maintain uniformity.

ELECTIVE COURSES AND GROUPS

The number of Elective Groups for PG PRIVATE COURSES (EXCEPT M.Com) shall be limited in Private Mode. Only one Elective Group comprising of three courses each for a programme is permitted and these elective courses shall be included either in IV Semester or be distributed

among III and IV Semesters . Details of ELECTIVE GROUPS allotted to Private Stream Courses (except M.Com) will be announced later.
