ORDER

As per the directions of UGC, a committee was constituted, vide U.O read 1) above, for the celebration of 75 years of India's Independence as "Bharat Ka Amrut Mahotsav". An online meeting of the committee was held on 1-6-2021 and resolved to recommend the following vide paper read 2) above

1. The Committee recommended to conduct various competitions for students like essay writing , quiz etc with the participation of teaching departments of the University as well as affiliated colleges.
2. The need to familiarize students to local and regional freedom fighters was discussed. Information regarding freedom fighters in the local area to be collected from the Freedom Fighter Cell in Collectorate, Kottayam and or General administration Department, Secretariat, Thiruvananthapuram.
3. Office of the Director of College Development Council is entrusted to give directions to affiliated colleges for conducting programmes in connection with BHARAT KA AMRUTH MAHOTSAV.
4. The book "Constituent Assembly Debates" may be made available in all Schools / Centres of the University. All affiliated colleges may be directed to make a copy of the same available in the College Library. If possible, University to think of purchasing copies of the book through the purchase committee of the University Library and distribute the book to all affiliated colleges with the help of Director of College Development Council. University Library to submit a proposal for the same.
5. The Committee recommended to include the Preamble of the Constitution in the syllabus as a zero credit course to enlighten the students the spirit of the Constitution - proposal to be discussed by CSS committee. Further, a board to be publicly displayed in all University Departments / Schools / Centers as well as in the Administration Block and Pareeksha Bhavan with the National Pledge of India. Estate officer is entrusted to complete the work.
6. Discussion on the Constitution of India may be conducted once in a week and the same may be recorded and published through Youtube. K.N Raj Centre and School of International Relations and Politics to be entrusted

with the task.

7. Webinars and essay /quiz competitions may be conducted on freedom struggle and freedom fighters for students as well as teachers. Cash awards may be distributed to the winners of the competitions. The School of Gandhian Thought and Development Studies is to be entrusted with the task of conducting these activities in the University Schools / Centres. The Directorate of Student Services(DSS) and the Directorate of College Development Council (DCDC) be entrusted the task of conducting the programmes in the colleges affiliated to the University. The expenses for the same may be met from the funds allocated to DSS, DSU and NSS. Certificates to be issued to the participants by DSS and DCDC.

8. Recommended to start a Digital / Online Department in the University using MOOC platform which gives lectures of eminent persons. Virtual chair may also be constituted. Cooperation of Kerala Council for Historical Research , Kerala State Higher Education Council etc may also be sought. A Committee with the following members may be entrusted the responsibility of implementing the concept of Digital Department.
