ORDER

The Expert Committee vide paper(1)above made the following recommendations in response to the clarifications sought for on the following issues which caused certain practical problems in the course mapping of BHM programme in University software.

1.VI semester paper BHM31(BH6CRP31 as in 2020 Scheme)(Industrial Exposure Training and Project Report):As per the Scheme, the marks for Project Report is 200,for Log Book is 50 and for Project Viva is 50.As there is no separate course code for Log Book, clarification was sought for as to whether the marks for Project Report and that of Log Book can be combined or not. The Expert Committee recommended that the marks for Project Report and Logbook can be combined ,as such, the total marks for the same will be 250.

2.VIII semester paper BHM42(BH8CRP42 as in 2020 Scheme)(Hospitality Research Project) : The subject is shown as a theory paper in the scheme. The Expert Committe has clarified that it can be treated as practical paper.

3.VIII semester BHM43 (BH8ECP01,BH8ECP02,BH8ECP03,&BH8ECP04 as in 2020 Scheme)Elective subject papers : As per the Scheme, separate marks were shown for External and Internal evaluation ,but it has been clarified that the paper, though having both external and internal evaluations, no separate minimum and maximum marks are provided in the scheme as in the case of all practical papers where 20 per cent of marks are provided as internal evaluation marks and this facility is being followed in the case of elective subjects too. As such the practice being followed is to award 20 per cent of the total marks (ie.,30 marks) by the respective internal examiners which will be handed over to the external examiner who prepares the total marks for the paper taking into account the marks awarded after both the evaluations and there is only single External mark entry for the same.

The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has approved the above recommendations of the Expert Committee by exercising powers under section 10(17),chapter 3 of Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985.
