The admission schedule for MBA programme in the affiliated colleges of the University for the academic year 2021 -'22 is as follows .

ELIGIBILITY

A pass in any Bachelor's Degree Examination of Mahatma Gandhi University or an equivalent degree from any other University duly recognized by Mahatma Gandhi University with not less than 50% marks in the aggregate for all the parts of examination or a Master's Degree examination with 50% marks in aggregate in addition to qualifying KMAT/ CMAT/ CAT. Under grading system, C Grade of Mahatma Gandhi University or equivalent thereto from the other recognized Universities with not less than 50% marks in aggregate is required to become eligible for admission. It is the responsibility of the Director/ Principal to ensure that eligibility criteria is strictly observed in the admission procedure. For SC/ST students, a pass in any Bachelor's Degree examination is needed. The reservation rules are applicable as per the Government and University norms in all the affiliated colleges. Those who are awaiting final semester result can also apply .

Vide U.O. No.6055/AIV/2/2018/Academic dtd 09.08.2018,. Cut off marks of C-MAT,CAT entrance examinations had been fixed as follows:

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admission to MBA full time programme shall be strictly on the basis of merit as determined by the entrance examination (KMAT Kerala/CMAT/CAT). Group Discussion and Personal Interview are waived during this academic year due to travel ban and the present pandemic situation.

- Candidates who have passed qualifying examinations from other Universities/Institutions and not approved by the University shall not be admitted unless eligibility certificates are produced.
- Candidates belonging to SEBC and OEC are allowed a concession of 3% & 5% marks respectively in the prescribed minimum marks for admission to the above programme.
- All candidates admitted to MBA programme shall produce original degree certificates before the commencement of first semester examinations.
