## ORDER

The University had granted provisional affiliation to the four self-financing Law Colleges: Al-Azhar Law College, Thodupuzha for conducting BA LLB (5 year) programme, vide paper (1) read above, CSI College for Legal Studies, Kanakkari, Ettumanoor, for conducting BA LLB (5 year) programme, vide paper (2) read above, Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Aluva, for conducting LLB (5 year) programme, vide paper (3) read above and Co-Operative School of Law, Thodupuzha for conducting LLB (5 year) programme vide paper (4) read above, with 60 seats each during the academic years 2012-13 – 2013-14 for seeking approval of the Bar Council of India.

Accordingly, the Educational Agencies of the colleges approached the Bar Council of India (BCI) for inspection/recognition and the BCI, after inspection has granted temporary approval of affiliation to the above mentioned four colleges: Al-Azhar Law College for conducting BA LLB (5 year) programme for 2013-14 academic year vide paper (5) read above, CSI College for Legal Studies for conducting BA LLB (Hons) programme for two years i.e. from 2013-14 & 2014-15, vide paper (6) read above, Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies for conducting BA LLB (5 year) programme for two years i.e. 2013-14 & 2014-15 vide paper (7) read above and Co-Operative School of Law for conducting BBA LLB (5 year) programme for two years i.e. 2013-14 & 2014-15 vide paper (8) read above.

Considering the requests received from the Educational Agencies of the colleges concerned vide paper (9) read above and all the relevant matters in detail, the Syndicate Standing Committee on Affiliation vide paper (10) read above has resolved to grant provisional affiliation to the following Law Colleges as per the NOC given by the Government of Kerala and the temporary approval of affiliation issued by the Bar Council of India as detailed below:

The Vice-Chancellor exercising powers under Chapter 3, Section 10(17) of the Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985, has approved the above recommendations of the Syndicate Standing Committee on Affiliation.

The permission to start the above Programmes is subject to the following conditions:

1. The above permission initially is for the academic year 2013-14 only and the institution shall observe all the conditions laid down in the provisional affiliation order issued by the University and the letter from the Bar Council of India vide papers (1) to (4) and (5) to (8) respectively.
2. The Educational Agency shall furnish a financial guarantee of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs only) as provided in the Mahatma Gandhi University Statutes, 1997.
3. The admission of the students, commencement of classes, teacher student ratio and payment of salary to teachers for the said programmes in the College shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the University, Bar Council of India and Govt. of Kerala.
4. The institution shall observe the admission norms regarding the eligibility of candidates and the norms of reservation framed by the Government, Commissioner of Entrance Examinations, University and the Bar Council of India.
5. The Management shall prepare and present the students in accordance with the laws of the University for the examination and as per the approved scheme and syllabus of the University in the subjects concerned.
6. The Educational Agency shall set apart 50% of the seats of the Courses for being filled up by the Government or such authority determined by Government on the basis of merit and reservation principles followed by the Government and the remaining 50% filled by the Educational Agency on the basis of merit.
7. The details of various items of fees related to the programme are given below:
  - a) Tuition fee – to be fixed by Government.
  - b) Students insurance premium @ Rs.10/- per student per year.
  - c) Students Welfare Fund @ Rs. 10/- per student per year.
  - d) University Union Fee @ Rs. 30/- per student per year.
  - e) Sports affiliation fee @ Rs. 150/- per student per year to be utilized in the ratio 50:50 by the University and the College.
  - f) Collection of Annual Administration Fee @ Rs.700/- per student per year.
  - g) Students affiliation fee @ Rs.300/- collected on one time basis from all students shall be remitted to the University within fifteen days after closing of the admission.
8. The College shall submit the list of students admitted and remit the fees due to University within 15 days after closing admission.
9. There shall not be any financial commitment to the Government/University.
10. Non-Compliance with any of the above conditions would lead to the withdrawal of the affiliation without any notice.

Orders are issued accordingly.
