Mahatma Gandhi University has instituted two Post Doctoral Fellowship in each of the University Departments of Teaching and Research, provided the department has a minimum of ten PhD scholars working under them. The amount of the fellowship will be Rs. 35,000/- per month and contingent grant of Rs. 50,000/- per year for a period not exceeding two years.

Applications are invited in the prescribed form (available in the University Website - www.mgu.ac.in) from eligible candidates, for the award of Post-Doctoral Fellowship (Full-time research) for the year 2022. Duly filled application along with supporting documents should be submitted to the respective University departments. The last date of receipt of the applications in the concerned University Teaching Department is 30.09.2022 till 5PM.

## **Eligibility**

- Those who hold a PhD degree from this University or from any other University recognized as equivalent thereto, at the time of application are eligible to apply for the fellowship, provided the PhD degree was awarded within three years immediately preceding the date of the application and the candidate is below 40 years of age at the time of application. Women and SC/ST candidates have an exemption of 3 years.
- Selection for Post Doctoral Fellowship shall be based on Reservation criteria as per existing University Norms.
- Applicant should have published articles in recognized research journals during the period of research.

- I. Post Doctoral Fellowship shall be awarded to the candidates registering themselves at any of the statutory University Departments of Teaching and Research, provided they have a minimum of ten PhD Scholars working in their departments.
- II. Term of the Fellowship shall not exceed two years.
- III. The Research Fellow shall be awarded a stipend of Rs. 35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand only) per month and contingent grant of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) per year.
- IV. Those who hold a PhD degree from this University or from any other University recognized as equivalent thereto, at the time of application are eligible to apply for the fellowship, provided the PhD degree was awarded within three years immediately preceding the date of the application and the candidate is below 40 years of age at the time of application. Women and SC/ST candidates have an exemption of 3 years.
- V. There shall be a Mentor for each scholar in the University departments concerned. For qualifying as a Mentor he/she should have produced a minimum of 3 PhD. A Mentor cannot attach more than 1 scholar within a period of three years.
- VI. The application shall be accompanied by copies of certificate to prove age, qualifications and a detailed plan of work (Research Proposal) for a specific time bound project on which research is proposed to be carried out during the term of the fellowship and it should be attested by the Mentor.
- VII. All applications must be routed through their Mentor and the Head of the Department failing which the same will be rejected.
- VIII. Applications completed in all respect must be submitted to the University Teaching Department concerned.
