ORDER

The Principal, PGM College, Devagiri P.O, Kangazha, Kottayam, vide paper read as (1) above, submitted application for starting 4 new programmes in the College during the academic year 2022-'23. As per the U.O. read as paper (2) above, the Vice Chancellor accorded sanction to the College for starting the new Programme, 'BA Animation and Graphic Design' during the academic year 2022-'23.

Subsequently, the Educational Agency filed a Writ Petition (C) No. 25691/2022 before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala against the rejection of application for the other 3 programmes by the University. In the meanwhile, the Principal, PGM College, Devagiri P.O., Kangazha vide paper read as (3) above, submitted another application to the University for sanction of the aforesaid 3 programmes.

The Hon'ble High Court in its Judgement dated 19.08.2022 vide paper read as (4) above, directed the University to consider the application for the new programmes, seek the views of the Government and take a final decision within two months.

In the light of the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court dated, 19.08.2022 in Writ Petition (C) No. 25691/2022, the Syndicate at its meeting held on 17.09.2022 decided to grant one more programme - 'B.A Animation and Visual Effects' (40) to the PGM College subject to the approval of the Government and the resultant University Order read as paper (5) above was issued. Subsequently, the University vide its letter read as paper (6) above, sought the views of the Government of Kerala in the matter.

The Government of Kerala, vide its Letter read as paper (7) above, accorded administrative sanction for starting the new Programme 'B.A Animation and Visual Effects' during the Academic Year 2022-'23 in PGM College, Devagiri P.O., Kangazha, Kottayam.

Thereafter, as directed by the University, vide paper read as (8) above, the Principal, PGM College, Devagiri P.O., Kangazha, Kottayam, furnished a copy of the signed agreement executed between the College and the Government along with an affidavit regarding the submission of the agreement to the Department of Higher Education. As deemed by the MG University Statutes 1997, the College signed an agreement with the University too.

Sanction has, therefore, been accorded by the Vice Chancellor to the following.

- 1. To start the new Programme, 'B.A Animation and Visual Effects' in PGM College, Devagiri P.O., Kangazha, Kottayam, during the academic year 2022-'23.
- 2. To include the programme 'B.A Animation and Visual Effects' in PGM College, Devagiri P.O., Kangazha, Kottayam in the CAP 2022-'23.

The affiliation granted shall be subject to the compliance of Act/Statutes/bye-Laws/rules and regulations of the University and the UGC on instructional and infrastructural facilities, faculty, qualifications etc.

Provisional affiliation is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The provisional affiliation is granted initially for a period of one Academic Year only.
- 2. The affiliation of the programme is subject to the approval of regulatory authority, if any.
- 3. The Management shall prepare and present the students in accordance with the laws of the University for the examination and as per the approved scheme and syllabus of the University in the subjects concerned.
- 4. As per G O read (7) above, the Educational Agency shall set apart 50% of the seats of the course for being filled up by the Government or such Authority determined by Government on the basis of merit and reservation principles followed by the Government and the remaining 50% filled by the Educational Agency on the basis of merit.

- b) Students insurance premium @ Rs.23/- per student per year.
- c) Students welfare fund @ Rs. 35/- per student per year.
- d) University Union fee @ Rs. 55/- per student per year.
- e) Sports affiliation fee @ Rs. 225/- per student per year to be utilised in the ratio @ 50:50 by the University and the college.
- f) The collection of annual administration fee from the students under any circumstances is not permitted.
- g) Student's affiliation fee @ Rs.600/- & Rs.800/- for UG & PG courses collected on one time basis from all students shall be remitted to the university within 15 days after closing admission.
- 5. The rate of Tuition Fee is as per Government/University orders issued from time to time.
- 6. The Educational Agency shall furnish an undertaking in stamp paper worth Rs.100/- to the University to carry out faithfully, the provisions of the Act, Statute, Ordinance and Regulations and the directions issued by the University from time to time, so far as they are related to the college, and to appoint and fix the service conditions of the teaching & non teaching staff in the college for conducting the courses as followed by the Government on conducting similar courses. The Principal of the college shall endorse the undertaking.
- 7. The Educational Agency will agree to collect only such fees as determined by the Government/University from time to time from the students admitted to the course.
- 8. The college shall submit the list of students admitted and remit the fees due to the University within 15 days after closing admission.
- 9. Non-compliance with any of the above conditions would lead to the withdrawal of the affiliation without any prior notice.

Orders are issued accordingly.
