ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

BPEd PROGRAMME 2023-24

Applications are invited for admission to the Bachelor of Physical Education (BPEd) Programme at St Joseph's Academy of Higher Education & Research , Moolamattom for the academic year 2023-24.

Duration of the Programme	:	Two Years (Four semesters)
Intake of students	:	50 (Fifty only) [50% Merit & 50% Management]

Eligibility for Admission:

- a) Candidates should have passed the corresponding Degree Examination under the 10 +2 +3 pattern with one core/main subject and two complementary/subsidiary subjects from any of the Universities in Kerala or of any other university recognized by Mahatma Gandhi University as equivalent thereto for admission, subject to the stipulation regarding marks

Or

- b) Candidates who have passed Degree examination with Double or Triple main subject + or candidates who have passed the Degree Examination in Vocational or Specialized Programmes are also eligible for admission. However , they have to submit copy of the Equivalency/Eligibility Certificate from Mahatma Gandhi University, stating that, their Qualifying Examination is recognized for seeking admission to the relevant P.G. Degree Course(s) as applicable, at the time of admission. This provision is not applicable in the case of those applicants who have passed their qualifying examination from MG University

AGE LIMIT:-There in no upper and lower age limit for admission to postgraduate programmes.

- c) Candidates should be physically fit for daily heavy load of physical activities and should not have any physical deformity or mental disability

Selection Criteria:

The candidates shall be selected for admission from the rank list prepared on the basis of the following criteria.

a) Written test (General English, General Knowledge)	50 marks
b) Game proficiency(Playing ability of any one game)	15 marks
c) Sports achievements (on the basis of sports merit certificates)	10 marks
d) Physical fitness test (AAHPERD)	25 marks
Total: 100 marks	

General reservation rules applicable for admission to post graduate degree programme as prescribed in the M G University PG Cap admission prospectus shall be followed while admitting candidates from the rank list.

Eligible candidates will be called for a Written Test and Physical Fitness Test. The candidates should bring duly certified Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format on the day of the Entrance Test.

- 4 **Last date of receipt of filled up application form along with application fee receipt is 15th June 2023.**

- 5 The Application fee is Rs.1300/-for All Candidates except SC/ST & Rs 650/- for SC/ST candidates. Candidates shall remit the **APPLICATION FEE** through MGU online payment gateway under the head "**Fee From Department**"
- 6 Candidates awaiting final results of the qualifying examination can also apply, provided they produce mark lists of the qualifying examination on or before the last date for the same as instructed by the University.
- 7 Reservation, relaxation in minimum marks based on income caste, etc. will be allowed according to the rules of the University.
- 8 The programme will be conducted under Choice Based Credit & Semester System.
