**Abstract**

Five year Integrated BA/B Com/BBA LL B Programmes Regulations 2011 - Internal Re-do - Recommendations of the Chairperson, Board of Studies in Law (UG &PG) - Approved - Orders issued.

**ORDER**

As per the Five Year BA /B Com /BBA LL B Programmes Regulations 2011, there is no provision for internal re-do. A number of students who got admitted to the Five Year BA /B Com /BBA LL B Programmes during the period from 2011 to 2017 submitted applications for providing the benefit of internal re-do. The University considered the matter and as per the U O read as paper (3) above, Dr. Giri Sankar S S , Chairperson, Board of Studies in Law ( UG & PG) was assigned to study and submit concrete proposals for providing the benefit of internal re-do to students who studied the Five Year BA /B Com /BBA LL B Programmes under the Five Year BA /B Com /BBA LL B Programmes Regulations 2011 and the Vice Chancellor to take appropriate decision on the matter. Accordingly the Chairperson, Board of Studies in Law ( UG & PG) submitted the following recommendations.

The consolidated recommendations regarding the permission for redoing of internals for the students who have been admitted from 2011 to 2017 which governed by the 2011 common regulation for five year integrated LL.B programmes.

- a. The opportunity to Redo Internals shall be availed only by the students who are admitted in the time frame mentioned above who have not successfully completed the Programme.
- b. The relaxations made in this context should be confined strictly as a onetime measure, to the students who were admitted in the time frame of 2011 to 2017 under Common Regulations 2011, who could not successfully complete the Programme due to scoring low marks/ not appeared in the Internal Examination in the respective Theory Papers and Practical papers.
- c. The students may be allowed to redo the internals in those papers without any minimum mark barrier for both Internal Assessment done as well as in the Theory Paper as spelt out in The Common Regulation 2011 or suggested afterwards.
- d. Instead of 4 modules of assessment, while redoing Internals, the assessment for the modules of Assignment (5 marks), Presentation (5 marks) and Test Paper (10 marks) alone shall be reckoned for a cumulative assessment of a maximum of 20 marks. The marks so secured shall be recorded

as the marks secured out of total marks of 25 as per the Scheme, as attendance is not a reckoning factor. The marks of the Internals redone should be reckoned along with the external examinations as per the relevant University Orders and mark list are also to be issued accordingly.

e. In the matter of Redo of the Practical Components, the following category of students admitted in various years whose Scheme of Examination as per the Common Regulation, 2011 is External (70 marks) and Internal Examinations (30 marks) in its inception, who were not able to attend / or secured low marks in their Internal Assessment module (30 Marks) in the Three Clinical Papers - FL-40- Alternative Dispute Resolution, FL-41-Drafting, Pleading and Conveyancing , FL-42- Professional Ethics, Accountancy for Lawyers and Bar Bench relations are to be allowed to Redo the internal component without any barrier on marks if any they have scored in the previous regular appearance. The External Examinations (70 Marks) can be conducted as Supplementary after notifying the same or by Mercy Chance as decided by the University.

f. The Scheme of Examination of the Practical/ Clinical Papers having been changed vide U.O. No. 3924/Ac AIV/2018/Acad. dated 10.05.2018 to that of Fully Internally assessed paper carrying 100 marks. In this context, the students who were admitted as reflected in the following table shall be allowed to Redo the same if the candidates have failed to secure 50% marks necessary for passing the paper. The heads of the institutions shall take steps to provide the opportunity for the students who are permitted by the University to Redo the Practical Papers to allow them to sit along with the batches in the semesters in which the respective Practical / Clinical papers are offered presently in the institutions for the batches admitted as per Regulations 2018. The marks of the Internals so redone should be reckoned along with the external examinations as per the relevant University Orders and mark lists also are to be issued accordingly.

g. The Internal Redo examinations of the 1st to 10th semester may be notified as- *the students who fulfil the above conditions and intend to re-do the internals shall make an application to the University for each semester separately with a fee of Rs.5000(Rupees Five Thousand Only) / Subject along with the mark list of the last attended exam for the semester. Applications for all the required semesters shall be submitted together - and conducted for better co-ordination and*

rationalization.

h. The candidates shall be allowed a single chance to avail the Redoing the Internals and any candidates who have earlier availed the chances for Redo shall be given opportunity to Redo internals for those subjects/papers they have not attempted.

i. The grace period for cancellation of student registration for some batches of students under the Common Regulation, 2011 allowed, if found lapsed may be waived till 31 st December, 2024 enabling the candidates to avail this opportunity for redo.

j. Once a candidate secures an Order for Redo from the University after remitting the prescribed fees Rs 5000/-(Rupees five Thousand only ) per subject set by the University, the heads of the institutions shall take expeditious steps to arrange for the same and forward the mark list to the University well within the time limit. The modality of conducting Redo and the time frame suggested by the Board of Studies is shown below (i-vii):-

*(i) On verification of the eligibility of the student for re-doing internals, the University may issue an order to the college concerned for the purpose.*

*(ii) The Head of the institution, on receipt of the University order, shall make arrangements for facilitating re-doing the internals preferably by a teacher who had not imparted instructions in the concerned theory paper(s) while the candidates were prosecuting their regular studies.*

*(iii) The student shall re-do the required components of internal assessment as instructed by the teacher concerned in accordance with Regulations applicable to the candidate concerned and attendance will not be a reckoning factor. Hence the assessment for the modules of Assignment, Presentation and Test Paper for a cumulative assessment of a maximum of 20 marks shall be done for Theory Papers/subjects..*

*(iv) A maximum of 90 working days may be given for completing the internal assessment process of the Theory papers by the teacher concerned. If the student accomplishes the requirement expeditiously, the teacher may not wait for the maximum period to lapse, but forward the marks expeditiously to the Head of the Institution.*

*v) The revised marks shall be forwarded from the college to the University within 100 working days from receipt of the University order and if the teacher concerned is able to expeditiously forward the marks secured in the internal redo, the marks may be forwarded to the University as expeditiously as possible.*

*vi) The students who have to accomplish the redoing of compulsory clinical papers/practical papers may accomplish the same not before the lapse of an Year since securing the Order from the University and the Head of the institution shall take steps to do the assessment part alone of such papers along with the regular batches which offers the Four Compulsory/ Clinical papers.*

*vii) The reckoning of the marks of internal redo of the Theory Paper shall be in terms of the U.O. 3701/AC A 4/2020/MGU dtd 19-08-2020 viz., "the first of the examinations in which the addition of the internal redo marks will help a candidate to pass" along with the moderation awarded by the respective Pass Board.*

*viii) The Month and year of passing of the subject as a result of the internal improvement shall be considered as the month and year of passing the subject and reflected in the mark sheet accordingly.*

The Vice Chancellor has approved the aforementioned recommendations of the Chairperson, Board of Studies in Law (UG & PG).

Orders are issued accordingly.
