The conference, Gendered Spaces: Digressions in Literary Discourses, aims at exploring and discussing gender representations and their political markers in socio-cultural milieus.

The political complexity posited by body, power, and gender at the forefront has been discussed in history and literature across time. However, they advance to the spatio-temporal dimensions of cultural diversity and social identities/beingnesses today. Therefore, subjecting this to serious scholarly discussions, focusing on state, citizenship, and expressions, strengthens a new epistemological direction, opening up the possibility of new epistemic models. At this juncture, 75 years after the publication of Simone de Beauvoir's *The Second Sex*, addressing the current direction of gender debates is a scholarly task. It is high time for academia to recognise that the discussions on gender and sexual differences should have continuity.

We invite papers in English and Malayalam that critically study state, citizenship, expressions, and cultural-social-literary discourses/representations.
