ABOUT THE EVENT

The seminar envisions a platform for rigorous academic and experiential engagement, encouraging discourses on and around contemporary cultural and epistemological spaces.

From time immemorial, through languages, histories and lore, humankind has attempted to engender gendered spaces. Simone de Beauvoir's *The Second Sex*, celebrating its 76th year of publication, has posited significant ontological and epistemological questions regarding body and sex. Later, Kate Millet, Bell Hooks, Audre Lorde, Toril Moi, Sara Heinaama, Judith Butler, et al. developed deeper and broader perspectives on gender and sexuality. In Kerala's cultural and literary context, through literary media and activism, gender and sexuality have been expressed and asserted extensively from the early decades of the 20th century.

The seminar hopes to elicit critical dialogues, exploring the practices of empowerment and advocacy while critically examining the structures of power that shape our world, by closely analysing literatures and social movements on topics ranging from intersectionality, representations, gendered violence, present absences, and performative elements in literary narratives.
