### ORDER

A request has been received from the B.Voc Broadcasting and Journalism students of the 2022 admission batch of St. Paul's College, Kalamassery, seeking the conduct of a special supplementary examination for the fifth semester. It has also been stated in the request that special supplementary examinations for the fifth semester are currently being conducted for other degree programmes, and therefore the same provision may kindly be extended to B.Voc students as well.

As per the B.Voc Regulations 2018, supplementary examinations are not permitted for B.Voc programmes. For reappearance or improvement, students are required to appear along with the next batch. However, permitting a special supplementary examination for the fifth semester may help those students who have failed in the fifth semester to avoid the loss of one academic year. CBCS 2017 regulations permits a special supplementary exam for fifth semester . Extending the same provision to B.Voc programmes would require an amendment to the B.Voc Regulations 2018. Hence expert opinion in this regard was sought from the convener Expert Committee on Physics(UG) .

The expert committee discussed about the possibility of conducting special supplementary examination and the convener opined that:

" Such an exam will benefit students and will help them to save a year in qualifying their course. The University, at present conducts special supplementary examination for the CBCS students. In this circumstance, it will be a good decision to conduct special supplementary examination for the students who have failed in the fifth semester B.Voc Courses. So it is recommended that University may conduct special supplementary examination for the students who have failed in the fifth semester B.Voc courses. "

The recommendation of the Expert Committee Convener has been approved by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, exercising the powers as provided under Chapter III Section 10(17) of the Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985, on 13.03.2026.

Orders are issued accordingly.
