NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited for admission to the B.Ed Programmes in the affiliated Colleges of Mahatma Gandhi University for the academic year 2026-27. This is a programme leading to the Bachelors Degree in Education.

Details of the Programmes and Duration :

The programme extends for a period of two years/ four semesters. The course of study shall be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures and practical training as per Mahatma Gandhi University Regulations for the B Ed programmes.

Admission to seats which come under the purview of Centralized Allotment process (CAP)

Centralized Allotment Process:

Admission/ Allotment of seats under merit quota is governed by a Centralized Allotment Process. Selection/ Allotment of a candidate to any college will be based on the rank of the candidate and the availability of seats. While a reserved category candidate entitled to admission on the basis of his/her merit will have the option of taking admission to the colleges where a specified number of seats have been kept reserved for reserved category, but while computing the percentage of reservation he/ she will be deemed to have been admitted as an open category candidate and not as a reserved category candidate.

Details of seats that come under the ambit of Centralized Allotment Process:

- i. *Govt. Colleges*: Total seats available in government colleges except Sports/PD quota
- ii. *Aided Colleges*: Open quota seats(50% in the case of aided/aided forward community Colleges and 40% in the case of aided backward Community Colleges), seats earmarked for SC/ST candidates (15% for SC and 5% for ST categories) & Community Merit Quota Seats (10% in the case of aided/aided forward community Colleges and 20% in the case of aided backward Community Colleges)
- iii. *Unaided Colleges/ Unaided Programmes conducted in Aided Colleges*: 50% of the total seats including seats reserved for SC/ST, EWS and SEBC

Categorization of seats:

Seats available in B. Ed. colleges are mainly classified as Merit Seats, Community Quota Seats (in

Aided Colleges Only) and Management Quota seats.

(a) Merit Seats:

Admissions to merit seats in the Teacher Training Colleges shall be made through the Centralized Allotment Process on the basis of marks the applicants obtained in the qualifying examination and other rules of admission prescribed by the University and the Government.

(b) Community Merit Quota Seats:

The seats under community quota shall be reserved for students of the community to which the college belongs and such seats shall be filled on the basis of merit though CAP vide Order No.4529/AcA1/2026/MGU dated 28/04/2026 Candidates should apply through the separate link given in CAP portal for admission to Community Merit Seats.

(c) Management seats:

The seats in Aided and Unaided Colleges that are to be filled by the Managements concerned are classified as 'Management seats'.

How and When to Apply:

There is only a single application form for applying for admission to the B.Ed Degree

Programmes in various affiliated colleges. If a candidate submits more than one application his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.

Application fee:

The application fee will be as follows:

For all candidates except SC/ST : ` 1300/-

For SC/ST candidates : ` 650/-

Application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Steps for On-line Registration:

1. For online registration of personal and academic data, the candidates must visit the web site, ***www.cap. mgu.ac.in*** and click on the link "***B.Ed CAP- 2026***".
2. Follow the online instructions and fill in the personal details in the relevant fields provided.
3. Please take utmost care while entering the register number and other academic details of Under Graduate programme.
4. Please note that only one application can be generated using one mobile number and hence the applicant should be extremely careful while entering the details online.
5. Create a '***Password***'. (The password is mandatory for all future online operations). **The password created by the candidate should not be disclosed to others who may misuse it.** This may result in tampering with the options and the University will not be responsible for any such eventuality.
6. Fill in the Application Form with personal details, academic eligibility and the options correctly.
7. Pay the application fee by clicking on the "PAY NOW" button which will redirect you to the Online Payment Gateway. You can use Debit Card/ Credit Card or Internet Banking facility for making online payment.
8. After remitting the fee, you will be redirected back to the application page.
9. Upload the digital images of the documents in proof of academic eligibility /caste/community/bonus marks claimed etc.
10. Verify with the relevant documents and confirm the details entered on-line.
11. After satisfying himself/herself that the details entered are correct, the applicants shall press the Final Submission Button.
12. Take the print out of the confirmation page for your future reference.

Special Attention

After pressing final submission button, further modification of data (except options) is not possible. Hence, make double sure that all entries are made correctly before pressing final submission button. For a complete Illustration refer the appendix.

Eligibility, and Procedure for Online Registration of Options

Eligibility for registering options: The candidates, registering their options, should satisfy all the eligibility conditions with regard to academic qualifications stated in the Prospectus. Options of only those candidates who figure in the rank list will be processed for allotment.

The options for college(s) and Programme(s) should be done while submitting personal and academic data online or subsequently within the last date of submission of application.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

Types of Reservation : Out of the total Merit Seats available in Aided/Unaided affiliated colleges for B. Ed. Programmes, seats will be reserved for different categories under the following main items :

- a. Reservation for Persons with Disabilities
- b. Special Reservation and
- c. Mandatory Reservation

Candidates seeking admission to Community Quota (Aided Colleges only), Management Quota(Aided and Unaided Colleges and Unaided Programmes conducted in Aided Colleges), Sports Quota, and Persons with Disabilities Quota (in all Affiliated Colleges) should apply through CAP. University shall prepare and publish rank lists for Sports and PD quota and the colleges shall conduct admissions from the rank lists on the stipulated dates.

If vacancies arise due to discontinuation of candidates under the above quota, the next eligible candidate in the rank list shall be admitted. In case there is no eligible candidate, the vacant seat shall be merged with the general quota in the case of sports quota and cultural quota.

In the case of students from other Universities, Eligibility Certificate from Mahatma Gandhi University specifically stating that, their Qualifying examination is recognized for seeking admission to B.Ed. Degree course (not Higher Studies)in a particular optional subject/in a stream is mandatory at the time of admission to the course

Fee for various programmes in Govt.\Aided\Self financing Colleges for the admission to 2026-27 batches is available on the University CAP website.Collection of excess fee shall be viewed seriously and the University will initiate legal steps against such Colleges

The principals of all B.Ed Colleges are directed to comply with the above schedules of admission to B.Ed Programmes for the academic year 2026-27
