GATE 2027

- The Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) is a prestigious national-level examination.
- The examination assesses the candidates for a comprehensive understanding of different undergraduate-level subjects in Engineering/ Technology/ Science/ Architecture/ Commerce/ Arts/ Humanities.
- GATE 2027 is being conducted by IISc and IITs, on behalf of the National Coordination Board (NCB), Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India.
- GATE 2027 is being organised by the Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IITM).
- GATE 2027 will be conducted for 30 Test Papers as a Computer-Based Test (CBT).
- Candidates can choose to appear for either one or two papers.
- GATE score is valid for a period of THREE years from the date of announcement of results.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Candidates who are currently studying in the 3rd or higher years of any undergraduate degree program or who have completed any government-approved degree program in Engineering/ Technology/ Science/ Architecture/ Commerce/ Arts/ Humanities are eligible to appear for GATE 2027.

OPPORTUNITIES

- Candidates who qualify for GATE can seek admission with possible financial assistance to Master's programs, Direct Doctoral programs and Doctoral programs in relevant branches of Engineering/ Technology/ Architecture/ Science/ Commerce/ Arts/ Humanities in institutions supported by the Ministry of Education (MoE) and other Government agencies.
- GATE score is also used by colleges and institutions for admission to postgraduate programs without MoE scholarship.
- Several Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) have also been using GATE score for recruitment.
